Jeremiah 15:16. Your words were found, and I proceeded to eat them, and your word becomes to me the exultation and the rejoicing of my heart, for your name has been called upon me, O Yehowah God of armies.

- And he proceeded to say to me; Son of man, what you find, eat. Eat this roll, and go, speak to the house of Israel. (Ezekiel 3:1)
- And I took the little scroll out of the hand of the angel and ate it up, and in my mouth it was sweet as honey, but when I had eaten it up, my belly was made bitter. (Revelation 10:10)
- From the commandment of his lips I do not move away. I have treasured up the sayings of his mouth more than what is prescribed for me. (Job 23:12)
- I have taken your reminders as a possession to time indefinite, for they are the exultation of my heart. (Psalms 119:111)
- Why do you become like a man astounded, like a mighty man that is unable to do any saving? Yet you yourself are in the midst of us, O Yehowah, and upon us it is that your own name has been called. Do not let us down. (Jeremiah 14:9)
- In turn David said to the Philistine; You are coming to me with a sword and with a spear and with a javelin, but I am coming to you with the name of Yehowah of armies, the God of the battle lines of Israel, whom you have taunted. (1 Samuel 17:45)
- And Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo the prophet prophesied to the Jews who were in Judah and in Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel who was over them. (Ezra 5:1)
- In the way of your reminders I have exulted, just as over all other valuable things. (Psalms 119:14)
- I am exulting over your saying just as one does when finding much spoil. (Psalms 119:162)
- And you, O son of man, hear what I am speaking to you. Do not become rebellious like the rebellious house. Open your mouth and eat what I am giving you. (Ezekiel 2:8)

- And he went on to say to me; Son of man, you should cause your own belly to eat, that you may fill your very intestines with this roll that I am giving you. And I began to eat it, and it came to be in my mouth like honey for sweetness. (Ezekiel 3:3)
- Is it being said, O house of Jacob; Has the spirit of Yehowah become discontented, or are these his dealings? Do not my own words do good in the case of the one walking uprightly? (Micah 2:7)
