Jeremiah 15:5... For who will show compassion upon you, O Jerusalem, and who will sympathize with you, and who will turn aside to ask about your welfare?

[6] - References:

- Reproach itself has broken my heart, and the wound is incurable. And I kept hoping for someone to show sympathy, but there was none, and for comforters, but I found none. (Psalms 69:20)
- Those two things were befalling you. Who will sympathize with you? Despoiling and breakdown, and hunger and sword! Who will comfort you? (Isaiah 51:19)
- Is it nothing to all you who are passing along the way? Look and see. Does there exist any pain like my pain that has been severely dealt out to me, with which Yehowah has caused grief in the day of his burning anger? (Lamentations 1:12)
- And I will speak with them my judgments over all their badness, in that they have left me and they keep making sacrificial smoke to other gods and bowing down to the works of their own hands. (Jeremiah 1:16)
- Because there are two bad things that my people have done; They have left even me, the source of living water, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the water. (Jeremiah 2:13)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel compassion.

 According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah doing the smiting. (Ezekiel 7:9)
