Jeremiah 15:6... You yourself have deserted me, is the utterance of Yehowah. Backwards is the way you keep walking. And I shall stretch out my hand against you and bring you to ruin. I have got tired of feeling regret.

- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (Isaiah 1:4)
- But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went walking in the counsels in the stubbornness of their bad heart, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. (Jeremiah 7:24)
- Therefore here I am, I have stretched out my hand against you, and I will give you as something to plunder to the nations, and I will cut you off from the peoples and destroy you from the lands. I shall annihilate you, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:7)
- And I will stretch out my hand against Judah and against all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and I will cut off from this place the remaining ones of the Baal, the name of the foreign-god priests along with the priests. (Zephaniah 1:4)
- The anger of Yehowah will not turn back until he will have carried out and until he will have made the ideas of his heart come true. In the final part of the days you people will give your consideration to it with understanding. (Jeremiah 23:20)
- I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. It must come, and I will act. I shall not neglect, neither shall I feel sorry nor feel regret.

 According to your ways and according to your dealings they will certainly judge you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:14)
- From the hand of Sheol I shall redeem them, from death I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your destructiveness, O Sheol? Compassion itself will be concealed from my eyes. (Hosea 13:14)

- They have acted ruinously on their own part; They are not his children, the defect is their own. A generation crooked and twisted! (Deuteronomy 32:5)
- The Egyptians, though, are earthling men, and not God, and their horses are flesh, and not spirit. And Yehowah himself will stretch out his hand, and he that is offering help will have to stumble, and he that is being helped will have to fall, and at the same time they will all of them come to an end. (Isaiah 31:3)
- For the reason that they have left me and have proceeded to make this place unrecognizable and to make sacrificial smoke in it to other gods whom they had not known, they and their forefathers and the kings of Judah, and they have filled this place with the blood of the innocent ones. (Jeremiah 19:4)
- Then Yehowah said to me; What are you seeing, Amos? So I said; A plummet. And Yehowah went on to say; Here I am setting a plummet in the midst of my people Israel. I shall no more do any further excusing of it. (Amos 7:8)
- You people have made Yehowah weary by Your words, and You have said, In what way have we made him weary? By Your saying, Everyone that is doing bad is good in the eyes of Yehowah, and in such ones he himself has taken delight. Or; Where is the God of justice? (Malachi 2:17)
