

Jeremiah 17:13 **“O Yehowah, the hope of Israel, all those who are leaving you will be put to shame. Those apostatizing from me will be written down even in the earth, because they have left the source of living water, Yehowah.**

[18] - References:

- In you our fathers trusted, they trusted, and you kept providing them with escape. (**Psalms 22:4**)
- O you the **hope** of **Israel**, the Savior of him in the time of distress, why do you become like an alien resident in the land, and like a traveler that has turned aside to spend the night? (**Jeremiah 14:8**)
- All those finding them **have** eaten them up, and their own adversaries **have** said; We shall not become guilty, due to the fact that they **have** sinned against **Yehowah** the abiding place of righteousness and the **hope** of their forefathers, Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 50:7**)
- Let all those serving any carved image be ashamed, those who are making their boast in valueless gods. Bow **down** to him, all **you** gods. (**Psalms 97:7**)
- For, look! The very ones keeping away from you **will** perish. You **will** certainly silence every one immorally **leaving** you. (**Psalms 73:27**)
- And the crash of revoltors and that of sinful ones **will** be at the same time, and those **leaving Yehowah will** come to their finish. (**Isaiah 1:28**)
- For with you is the **source** of life, by light from you we can see light. (**Psalms 36:9**)
- Because there are two bad things that my people **have** done; They **have left even** me, the **source** of **living water**, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the **water**. (**Jeremiah 2:13**)
- And he showed me a river of **water** of life, clear as crystal, flowing out from the throne of God and of the Lamb. (**Revelation 22:1**)

- In case **you** should leave **Yehowah** and **you** do serve foreign gods, he also **will** certainly turn back and do **you** injury and exterminate **you** after he has done **you** good. (**Joshua 24:20**)
- For the reason that this people has rejected the **waters** of the Shiloah that are going gently, and there is exultation over Rezin and the son of Remaliah. (**Isaiah 8:6**)
- There **have** been transgressing and a denying of **Yehowah**, and there was a moving back from our God, a speaking of oppression and revolt, a conceiving and a muttering of words of falsehood from the very heart. (**Isaiah 59:13**)
- And I **will** speak with them my judgments over all their badness, in that they **have left** me and they keep making sacrificial smoke to other gods and bowing **down** to the works of their own hands. (**Jeremiah 1:16**)
- For my people **have** forgotten me in that they make sacrificial smoke to something worthless, and in that they make men stumble in their ways, the paths of long ago, to walk in roadways, a way not banked up. (**Jeremiah 18:15**)
- For the reason that they **have left** me and **have** proceeded to make this place unrecognizable and to make sacrificial smoke in it to other gods whom they had not known, they and their forefathers and the kings of Judah, and they **have** filled this place with the blood of the innocent ones. (**Jeremiah 19:4**)
- And it must occur in that day that **living waters will** go forth from Jerusalem, half of them to the eastern sea and half of them to the western sea. In summer and in winter it **will** occur. (**Zechariah 14:8**)
- And with every unrighteous deception for those who are perishing, as a retribution because they did not accept the love of the truth that they might be saved. (**2 Thessalonians 2:10**)
- If any man teaches other doctrine and does not assent to healthful words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, nor to the teaching that accords with godly devotion. (**1 Timothy 6:3**)
