[9] - References:

- **SEE** now that I, I am He, and there are no gods together with me. I put to death, and I make alive. I have severely wounded, and I, I **will** heal, and there is no one snatching out of my hand. (**Deuteronomy 32:39**)
- Show me favor, O **Yehowah**, for I am fading away. Heal me, O **Yehowah**, for my bones have been disturbed. (**Psalms 6:2**)
- In order that your beloved ones may be rescued, O do save with your right hand and answer us. (**Psalms 60:5**)
- And I have made you to this people a fortified copper wall, and they **will** certainly fight against you, but they **will** not prevail over you. For I am with you, to save you and to deliver you, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 15:20**)
- He is the One for you to **praise**, and he is your God, who has done with you these great and fear-inspiring things that your eyes have seen. (**Deuteronomy 10:21**)
