

Jeremiah 17:22· **And you must bring no load out of YOUR homes on the Sabbath day, and no work at all must you do. And you must sanctify the Sabbath day, just as I commanded YOUR forefathers.**

[8] - References:

- But the seventh day is a Sabbath to Yehowah your God. You must not do any work, you nor your son nor your daughter, your slave man nor your slave girl nor your domestic animal nor your alien resident who is inside your gates. (Exodus 20:10)
- Six days you are to do your work, but on the seventh day you are to desist, in order that your bull and your ass may rest and the son of your slave girl and the alien resident may refresh themselves. (Exodus 23:12)
- And as its grain offering two tenths of an ephah of fine flour moistened with oil, as an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a restful odor, and as its drink offering a fourth of a hin of wine. (Leviticus 23:13)
- As for you, speak to the sons of Israel, saying; Especially my Sabbaths you are to keep, for it is a sign between me and you during YOUR generations that you may know that I Yehowah am sanctifying you. (Exodus 31:13)
- And my Sabbaths I also gave to them, to become a sign between me and them, in order for them to know that I am Yehowah who is sanctifying them. (Ezekiel 20:12)
- Six days you will pick it up, but on the seventh day is a Sabbath. On it none will form. (Exodus 16:26)
- Six days you are to labor, but on the seventh day you will keep Sabbath. In plowing time and in harvest you will keep Sabbath. (Exodus 34:21)
- And sanctify my own Sabbaths, and they must serve as a sign between me and you, for you to know that I am Yehowah YOUR God. (Ezekiel 20:20)
