Jeremiah 18:16. In order to make their land an object of astonishment, for whistling at to time indefinite. Every last one passing along by it will stare in astonishment and shake his head.

- And where property of the Levites is not bought back, the house sold in the city of his possession must also go out in the Jubilee, because the houses of the cities of the Levites are their possession in the midst of the sons of Israel. (Leviticus 25:33)
- And I will make this city an object of astonishment and something to be whistled at. Every last one passing along by it will stare in astonishment and whistle over all its plagues. (Jeremiah 19:8)
- For by my own self I have sworn, is the utterance of Yehowah, that nothing but an object of astonishment, a reproach, a devastation and a malediction will Bozrah become, and all her own cities will become devastated places to time indefinite. (Jeremiah 49:13)
- And I will stretch out my hand against them and make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation worse than the wilderness toward Diblah, in all their dwelling places. And they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 6:14)
- Yes, all the nations will be bound to say; Why did Yehowah do like this to this land? Why the heat of this great anger?

 (Deuteronomy 29:24)
- And this house itself will become heaps of ruins. Everyone passing by it will stare in amazement and will certainly whistle and say, For what reason did Yehowah do like that to this land and this house? (1 Kings 9:8)
- At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept wagging their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the city of which they used to say, It is the perfection of prettiness, an exultation for all the earth? (Lamentations 2:15)
- And the statutes of Omri and all the work of the house of Ahab are observed, and you people walk in their counsels, to the end that I may make you an object of astonishment and her

- inhabitants something to be whistled at, and the reproach of peoples you men will bear. (Micah 6:16)
- Yehowah will strike you with the boil of Egypt and piles and eczema and skin eruption, from which you will not be able to be healed. (Deuteronomy 28:27)
- You set us as a proverbial saying among the nations, a shaking of the head among the national groups. (Psalms 44:14)
- And I, for my part, will lay the land desolate, and YOUR enemies who are dwelling in it will simply stare in amazement over it. (Leviticus 26:32)
- And Yehowah's indignation came to be against Judah and Jerusalem, so that he constituted them an object at which to quake, an object of astonishment and a cause for whistling, just as you are seeing with your own eyes. (2 Chronicles 29:8)
- And they cause one to stumble. But their tongue is against their own selves. All those looking upon them will shake their head. (Psalms 64:8)
- Here I am sending and I will take all the families of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, even sending to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and I will bring them against this land and against its inhabitants and against all these nations round about, and I will devote them to destruction and make them an object of astonishment and something to whistle at and places devastated to time indefinite. (Jeremiah 25:9)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Just as my anger and my rage have been poured out upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so my rage will be poured out upon you because of Your entering into Egypt, and You will certainly become a curse and an object of astonishment and a malediction and a reproach, and you will no more see this place. (Jeremiah 42:18)
- By your blood that you have shed you have become guilty, and by your dungy idols that you have made you have become unclean.

 And you bring your days near, and you will come to your years.

 That is why I must make you an object of reproach to the nations and of ieering to all the lands. (Ezekiel 22:4)

- As for merchants among the peoples, they will certainly whistle over you. Sudden terrors are what you must become, and you will be no more to time indefinite. (Ezekiel 27:36)
- Therefore prophesy, and you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason, even for the reason that there has been a lying desolate and a snapping at you from all sides, in order for you to become a possession to the remaining ones of the nations and you continue being talked about with the tongue and there is a bad report among people. (Ezekiel 36:3)
- And I also, for my part, shall certainly make you sick by striking you, there will be a desolating of you, on account of your sins. (Micah 6:13)
