

Jeremiah 18:17· **As with an east wind I shall scatter them before the enemy. The back, and not the face, I shall show them in the day of their disaster.**

[8] - References:

- With an east **wind** you wreck the ships of Tarshish. (**Psalms 48:7**)
- So I shall **scatter** them like stubble that is passing along in the **wind** from the wilderness. (**Jeremiah 13:24**)
- At that my anger will indeed blaze against them in that **day**, and I shall certainly forsake them and conceal my **face** from them, and they must become something to be consumed, and many calamities and distresses must come upon them, and they will be bound to say in that **day**; Is it not because our God is not in our midst that these calamities have come upon us? (**Deuteronomy 31:17**)
- They are saying to a tree; You are my father, and to a stone; You yourself brought me to birth. But to me they have turned the **back** of the neck and not the **face**. And in the time of their calamity they will say, Do rise up and save us! (**Jeremiah 2:27**)
- And now there is one request that I am making of you. Do not turn my **face** away. Accordingly she said to him; Speak. (**1 Kings 2:16**)
- An east **wind** will carry him off and he will go away, and it will whirl him away from his place. (**Job 27:21**)
- The **face** of Yehowah has divided them up. He will not look upon them again. Men will certainly **show** no consideration even for the priests. They will certainly **show** no favor even to the old men. (**Lamentations 4:16**)
- And I shall have to turn away my **face** from them, and they will actually profane my concealed place, and into it robbers will really come and profane it. (**Ezekiel 7:22**)
