- Rise up, and you **must** go down to the house of the **potter**, and there I shall cause you to hear my words. (**Jeremiah 18:2**)
- What? Does not the **potter** have authority over the clay to make from the same lump one vessel for an honorable use, another for a dishonorable use? (**Romans 9:21**)
- And you **must** take in your hand ten loaves of bread and sprinkled cakes and a **flask** of honey, and you **must** come in to him. He it is that will certainly tell you what is going to happen to the boy. (**1 Kings 14:3**)
- At that time **Yehowah** spoke by the hand of Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying; **Go**, and you **must** loosen the sackcloth from off your hips, and your sandals you should draw from off your feet. And he proceeded to do so, walking about naked and barefoot. (**Isaiah 20:2**)
