Jeremiah 19:4. For the reason that they have left me and have proceeded to make this place unrecognizable and to make sacrificial smoke in it to other gods whom they had not known, they and their forefathers and the kings of Judah, and they have filled this place with the blood of the innocent ones.

- Yehowah will send upon you the curse, confusion and rebuke in every undertaking of yours that you try to carry out, until you have been annihilated and have perished in a hurry, because of the badness of your practices in that you have forsaken me. (Deuteronomy 28:20)
- Due to the fact that they have left me and have gone making sacrificial smoke to other gods in order to offend me with all the work of their hands, and my rage has been set afire against this place and will not be extinguished. (2 Kings 22:17)
- But You men are those leaving Yehowah, those forgetting my holy mountain, those setting in order a table for the god of Good Luck and those filling up mixed wine for the god of Destiny. (Isaiah 65:11)
- Because there are two bad things that my people have done; They have left even me, the source of living water, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the water. (Jeremiah 2:13)
- You yourself have deserted me, is the utterance of Yehowah.
  Backwards is the way you keep walking. And I shall stretch out
  my hand against you and bring you to ruin. I have got tired of
  feeling regret. (Jeremiah 15:6)
- O Yehowah, the hope of Israel, all those who are leaving you will be put to shame. Those apostatizing from me will be written down even in the earth, because they have left the source of living water, Yehowah. (Jeremiah 17:13)
- We have sinned and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, and there has been a turning aside from your commandments and from your judicial decisions. (Daniel 9:5)

- And he built altars in the house of Yehowah, respecting which Yehowah had said; In Jerusalem my name will prove to be to time indefinite. (2 Chronicles 33:4)
- In case your brother, the son of your mother, or your son or your daughter or your cherished wife or your companion who is like your own soul, should try to allure you in secrecy, saying; Let us go and serve other gods, whom you have not known, neither you nor your forefathers. (Deuteronomy 13:6)
- They went sacrificing to demons, not to God, Gods whom they had not known, new ones who recently came in, with whom YOUR forefathers were not acquainted. (Deuteronomy 32:17)
- Can there be stealing, murdering and committing adultery and swearing falsely and making sacrificial smoke to Baal and walking after other gods whom you had not known. (Jeremiah 7:9)
- And there was also innocent blood that Manasseh shed in very great quantity, until he had filled Jerusalem from end to end, besides his sin with which he caused Judah to sin by doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah. (2 Kings 21:16)
- And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (2 Kings 24:4)
- Their own feet keep running to sheer badness, and they are in a hurry to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are hurtful thoughts, despoiling and breakdown are in their highways. (Isaiah 59:7)
- Also, in your skirts there have been found the blood marks of the souls of the innocent poor ones. Not in the act of breaking in have I found them, but they are upon all these. (Jeremiah 2:34)
- Because of the sins of her prophets, the errors of her priests, there were in the midst of her those pouring out the blood of righteous ones. (Lamentations 4:13)
- That there may come upon you all the righteous blood spilled on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah son of Barachiah, whom you murdered between the sanctuary and the altar. (Matthew 23:35)

- Because they poured out the blood of holy ones and of prophets, and you have given them blood to drink. They deserve it. (Revelation 16:6)
- And they proceeded to go and serve other gods and to bow down to them, gods that they had not known and he had not apportioned to them. (Deuteronomy 29:26)
- It is because of their badness that they did in order to offend me by going and making sacrificial smoke and rendering service to other gods whom they themselves had not known, neither you nor your forefathers. (Jeremiah 44:3)
- And he went on to say to me; Have you seen this, O son of man? Is it such a light thing to the house of Judah to do the detestable things that they have done here, that they have to fill the land with violence and that they should offend me again, and here they are thrusting out the shoot to my nose? (Ezekiel 8:17)
