Jeremiah 1:17... And as for you, you should gird up your hips, and you must rise up and speak to them everything that I myself command you. Do not be struck with any terror because of them, in order that I may not strike you with terror before them.

- And the very hand of Yehowah proved to be upon Elijah, so that he girded up his hips and went running ahead of Ahab all the way to Jezreel. (1 Kings 18:46)
- Immediately he said to Gehazi; Gird up your loins and take my staff in your hand and go. In case you encounter anyone, you must not greet him, and in case anyone should greet you, you must not answer him. And you must place my staff upon the face of the boy. (2 Kings 4:29)
- And Elisha the prophet, for his part, called one of the sons of the prophets and then said to him; Gird up your loins and take this flask of oil in your hand and go to Ramoth-gilead. (2 Kings 9:1)
- Gird up your loins, please, like an able-bodied man, and let me question you, and you inform me. (Job 38:3)
- Happy are those slaves whom the master on arriving finds watching! Truly I say to YOU, He will gird himself and make them recline at the table and will come alongside and minister to them. (Luke 12:37)
- Hence brace up Your minds for activity, keep Your senses completely, set Your hope upon the undeserved kindness that is to be brought to You at the revelation of Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 1:13)
- Have I not commanded you? Be courageous and strong. Do not suffer shock or be terrified, for Yehowah your God is with you wherever you go. (Joshua 1:9)
- And you, O son of man, do not be afraid of them, and of their words do not be afraid, because there are obstinate ones and things pricking you and it is among scorpions that you are dwelling. Of their words do not you be afraid, and at their faces do not you be struck with terror, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 2:6)

- At that the angel of Yehowah spoke to Elijah; Go down with him. Do not be afraid because of him. So he rose and went down with him to the king. (2 Kings 1:15)
- Listen to me, you the ones knowing righteousness, the people in whose heart is my Law. Do not be afraid of the reproach of mortal men, and do not be struck with terror just because of their abusive words. (Isaiah 51:7)
- At that Jeremiah said to all the princes and to all the people; It was Yehowah that sent me to prophesy concerning this house and concerning this city all the words that YOU have heard. (Jeremiah 26:12)
- Only You should by all means know that, if You are putting me to death, it is innocent blood that You are putting upon yourselves and upon this city and upon her inhabitants, for in truth Yehowah did send me to You to speak in Your ears all these words.

 (Jeremiah 26:15)
- Now it came about that as soon as Jeremiah finished speaking to all the people all the words of Yehowah their God with which Yehowah their God had sent him to them, even all these words. (Jeremiah 43:1)
- And you must speak my words to them, regardless of whether they hear or they refrain, for they are a case of rebellion. (Ezekiel 2:7)
- Now as regards you, O son of man, a watchman is what I have made you to the house of Israel, and at my mouth you must hear the word and give them warning from me. (Ezekiel 33:7)
- And Haggai the messenger of Yehowah went on to say to the people according to the messenger's commission from Yehowah, saying; I am with you people, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Haggai 1:13)
