Jeremiah 1:18... But as for me, here I have made you today a fortified city and an iron pillar and copper walls against all the land, toward the kings of Judah, toward her princes, toward her priests and toward the people of the land. 1

Footnote: And toward the people of the land Hebrew, *u·le`am' ha·´a'rets* Later used contemptuously, compare (John 7:47-49)

- And I have made you to this people a fortified copper wall, and they will certainly fight against you, but they will not prevail over you. For I am with you, to save you and to deliver you, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 15:20)
- But Yehowah was with me like a terrible mighty one. That is why the very ones persecuting me will stumble and not prevail. They will certainly be put to much shame, because they will not have prospered. Their indefinitely lasting humiliation will be one that will not be forgotten. (Jeremiah 20:11)
- Look! I have made your face exactly as hard as their faces and your forehead exactly as hard as their foreheads. (Ezekiel 3:8)
- And, on the other hand, I myself have become full of power, with the spirit of Yehowah, and of justice and mightiness, in order to tell to Jacob his revolt and to Israel his sin. (Micah 3:8)
- At that Jeremiah said to all the princes and to all the people; It was Yehowah that sent me to prophesy concerning this house and concerning this city all the words that you have heard.

- And we have not listened to your servants the prophets, who have spoken in your name to our kings, our princes and our forefathers and to all the people of the land. (Daniel 9:6)
- Like a diamond, harder than flint, I have made your forehead. You must not be afraid of them, and you must not be struck with terror at their faces, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 3:9)
