

**Jeremiah 1:3** And it kept on occurring in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, the king of Judah, until the completion of the eleventh year of Zedekiah<sup>1</sup> the son of Josiah, the king of Judah, until Jerusalem went into exile in the fifth month.

**Footnote:** Of Zedekiah Hebrew, *leTsidh·qi·ya'hu*, meaning Yehowah Is Righteousness

- In his **days** Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of Babylon came up, and so **Jehoiakim** became his servant for three **years**. However, he turned back and rebelled against him. (**2 Kings 24:1**)
- Furthermore, the **king** of Egypt made Eliakim his brother **king** over **Judah** and **Jerusalem** and changed his name to **Jehoiakim**, but his brother Jehoahaz, Necho took and brought to Egypt. (**2 Chronicles 36:4**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah concerning all the people of **Judah** in the fourth **year** of **Jehoiakim** the **son** of **Josiah**, the **king** of **Judah**, that is, the first **year** of Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of Babylon. (**Jeremiah 25:1**)
- Twenty-one **years** old was **Zedekiah** when he began to reign, and for eleven **years** he reigned in **Jerusalem**. And his mother's name was Hamutal the daughter of Jeremiah from Libnah. (**2 Kings 24:18**)
- And he continued to do what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, according to all that **Jehoiakim** had done. (**2 Kings 24:19**)
- Twenty-one **years** old was **Zedekiah** when he began to reign, and for eleven **years** he reigned in **Jerusalem**. (**2 Chronicles 36:11**)
- Please inquire in our behalf of Yehowah, because Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of Babylon is making war against us. Perhaps Yehowah will do with us according to all his wonderful works, so that he will withdraw from us. (**Jeremiah 21:2**)
- In the **eleventh year** of **Zedekiah**, in the fourth **month**, on the ninth day of the **month**, the city was broken through. (**Jeremiah 39:2**)
- And in the **fifth month** on the seventh day of the **month**, that is to say, the nineteenth **year** of King Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of

- Babylon, Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard, the servant of the **king** of Babylon, came to **Jerusalem**. (**2 Kings 25:8**)
- And in the **fifth month**, on the tenth day of the **month**, that is, in the nineteenth **year** of King Nebuchadrezzar, the **king** of Babylon, Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard, who was standing before the **king** of Babylon, came into **Jerusalem**. (**Jeremiah 52:12**)
  - Twenty-five **years** old was **Jehoiakim** when he began to reign, and for eleven **years** he reigned in **Jerusalem**. And his mother's name was Zebidah the daughter of Pedaiiah from Rumah. (**2 Kings 23:36**)
  - In the beginning of the royal rule of **Jehoiakim** the **son** of **Josiah**, the **king** of **Judah**, this word occurred from Yehowah, saying; (**Jeremiah 26:1**)
