

**Jeremiah 20:2** Then Pashhur struck Jeremiah the prophet and put him into the stocks that were in the Upper Gate of Benjamin, which was in the house of Yehowah.

[15] - References:

- At this the High Priest Ananias ordered those standing by him to strike him on the mouth. (**Acts of Apostles 23:2**)
- However, Asa became offended at the seer and **put** him in the **house** of the **stocks**, because he was in a rage at him over this. And Asa began to crush some others of the people at that same time. (**2 Chronicles 16:10**)
- **Yehowah** himself has made you priest instead of Jehoiada the priest, in order to become the grand overseer of the **house** of **Yehowah** toward any man maddened and behaving like a **prophet**, and you must **put** him into the **stocks** and into the pillory. (**Jeremiah 29:26**)
- Because he got such an order, he threw them into the inner prison and made their feet fast in the **stocks**. (**Acts of Apostles 16:24**)
- And it came about that, as soon as the king heard the word of the man of the true God that he had called out against the altar in Bethel, Jeroboam at once thrust out his hand from off the altar, saying; **you** men, grab hold of him! Immediately his hand that he had thrust out against him became dried up, and he was not able to draw it back to himself. (**1 Kings 13:4**)
- Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah now approached and **struck** Micaiah on the cheek and said; In just which way did the spirit of **Yehowah** pass along from me to speak with you? (**2 Chronicles 18:23**)
- And **you** men must say; This is what the king has said; **Put** this fellow in the **house** of detention and feed him with a reduced allowance of bread and a reduced allowance of water until I return in peace. (**2 Chronicles 18:26**)
- He himself built the upper gate of Yehowah's **house**, and on the wall of Ophel he did a great deal of building. (**2 Chronicles 27:3**)

- He **puts** my feet in the **stocks**, the watches all my paths. (**Job 33:11**)
- And the princes began to get indignant at **Jeremiah**, and they **struck** him and **put** him into the **house** of fetters, in the **house** of Jehonathan the secretary, for this was what they had made the **house** of detention. (**Jeremiah 37:15**)
- And King Zedekiah proceeded to send and take **Jeremiah** the **prophet** to him to the third entryway, which is in the **house** of **Yehowah**, and then the king said to **Jeremiah**; I am asking something of you. Do not hide from me anything. (**Jeremiah 38:14**)
- The adversary has spread out his own hand against all her desirable things. For she has seen nations that have come into her sanctuary, whom you commanded that they should not come into the congregation belonging to you. (**Lamentations 1:10**)
- Then he thrust out the representation of a hand and took me by a tuft of hair of my head, and a spirit carried me between the earth and the heavens and brought me to Jerusalem in the visions of God, to the entrance of the inner gate that is facing northward, where the dwelling place is of the symbol of jealousy that is inciting to jealousy. (**Ezekiel 8:3**)
- And, look! There were six men coming from the direction of the upper gate that faces to the north, each one with his weapon for smashing in his hand, and there was one man in among them clothed with linen, with a secretary's inkhorn at his hips, and they proceeded to come in and stand beside the copper altar. (**Ezekiel 9:2**)
- Yes, others received their trial by mockings and scourgings, indeed, more than that, by bonds and prisons. (**Hebrews 11:36**)
