Jeremiah 21:12. O house of David, this is what Yehowah has said; Every morning render sentence in justice, and deliver the one being robbed out of the hand of the defrauder, that my rage may not go forth just like a fire and actually burn and there be no one to extinguish it because of the badness of your dealings.

- And a report was made to the house of David, saying; Syria has leaned upon Ephraim. And his heart and the heart of his people began to quiver, like the quivering of the trees of the forest because of a wind. (Isaiah 7:2)
- And he has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of David his servant. (Luke 1:69)
- Every morning I shall silence all the wicked ones of the earth, to cut off from the city of Yehowah all the practicers of what is hurtful. A prayer of the afflicted in case he grows feeble and pours out his concern before Yehowah himself. (Psalms 101:8)
- And David kept reigning over all Israel, and David was continually rendering judicial decision and righteousness for all his people. (2 Samuel 8:15)
- Learn to do good, search for justice, set right the oppressor, render judgment for the fatherless boy, plead the cause of the widow. (Isaiah 1:17)
- For if you will positively make your ways and your dealings good, if you will positively carry out justice between a man and his companion. (Jeremiah 7:5)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Render justice and righteousness, and deliver the one that is being robbed out of the hand of the defrauder, and do not maltreat any alien resident, fatherless boy or widow. Do them no violence. And do not shed any innocent blood in this place. (Jeremiah 22:3)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; With true justice do YOUR judging, and carry on with one another loving-kindness and mercies. (Zechariah 7:9)

- Let him judge the afflicted ones of the people, let him save the sons of the poor one, and let him crush the defrauder. (Psalms 72:4)
- He that is defrauding the lowly one has reproached his Maker, but the one showing favor to the poor one is glorifying Him. (Proverbs 14:31)
- The people of the land themselves have carried on a scheme of defrauding and have done a tearing away in robbery, and the afflicted one and the poor one they have maltreated, and the alien resident they have defrauded without justice. (Ezekiel 22:29)
- And they have desired fields and have seized them, also houses, and have taken them, and they have defrauded an able-bodied man and his household, a man and his hereditary possession.

 (Micah 2:2)
- For a fire has been ignited in my anger and it will burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it will consume the earth and its produce and will set ablaze the foundations of mountains. (Deuteronomy 32:22)
- Get yourselves circumcised to Yehowah, and take away the foreskins of Your hearts, You men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, that my rage may not go forth just like a fire, and it certainly burn with no one to do the extinguishing, on account of the badness of Your dealings. (Jeremiah 4:4)
- In the face of his denunciation who can stand? And who can rise up against the heat of his anger? His own rage will certainly be poured out like fire, and the very rocks will actually be pulled down because of him. (Nahum 1:6)
- Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury, but by the fire of his zeal the whole earth will be devoured, because he will make an extermination, indeed a terrible one, of all the inhabitants of the earth. (Zephaniah 1:18)
- And the vigorous man will certainly become tow, and the product of his activity a spark, and both of them will certainly go up in flames at the same time, with no one to do the extinguishing. (Isaiah 1:31)

- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Look! My anger and my rage are being poured forth upon this place, upon mankind and upon domestic animal, and upon the tree of the field and upon the fruitage of the ground, and it must burn, and it will not be extinguished. (Jeremiah 7:20)
- And I will bring you together and blow upon you with the fire of my fury, and you must be liquefied in the midst of her. (Ezekiel 22:21)
- Yehowah was righteous in the midst of her, he would do no unrighteousness. Morning by morning he kept giving his own judicial decision. At daylight it did not prove lacking. But the unrighteous one was knowing no shame. (Zephaniah 3:5)
