

Jeremiah 21:13 Here I am against you, O inhabitress of the low plain, O rock of the level land, is the utterance of Yehowah. As for you who are saying; Who will descend against us? And who will come into our dwellings?

[6] - References:

- Here I am **against** you, O ruinous mountain, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, you ruiner of the whole earth, and I **will** stretch out my hand **against** you and roll you away from the crags and make you a burnt-out mountain. (**Jeremiah 51:25**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; For the reason that **you** men have spoken untruth and **you** have visioned a lie, therefore here I am **against you**, is the **utterance** of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 13:8**)
- Consequently the king and his men went to Jerusalem **against** the Jebusites inhabiting the land, and they began to say to David; You **will** not **come** in here, but the blind and the lame ones **will** certainly turn you away, they thinking; David **will** not **come** in here. (**2 Samuel 5:6**)
- Why do you brag about the **low plains**, your flowing **low plain**, O daughter unfaithful, you the one trusting in her treasures, **saying; Who will come** to me? (**Jeremiah 49:4**)
- The kings of the earth and all the inhabitants of the productive land had not believed that the adversary and the enemy would **come** into the gates of Jerusalem. (**Lamentations 4:12**)
- The presumptuousness of your heart is what has deceived you, you who are residing in the retreats of the crag, the height where he dwells, **saying** in his heart, Who **will** bring me down to the earth? (**Obadiah 1:3**)
