- After that the sons of Israel inquired of **Yehowah**, as it was there that the ark of the covenant of the true God was in those days. (**Judges 20:27**)
- Go, **inquire** of **Yehowah** in my own **behalf** and in **behalf** of the people and in **behalf** of all Judah concerning the words of this book that has been found, for great is Yehowah's rage that has been set afire **against** us over the fact that our forefathers did not listen to the words of this book by doing according to all that is written concerning **us**. (**2 Kings 22:13**)
- And it came about in the ninth year of his being **king**, in the tenth month on the tenth day of the month, that Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of **Babylon** came, yes, he and all his military force, **against** Jerusalem and began camping **against** it and building **against** it a siege wall all around. (**2 Kings 25:1**)
- Therefore this is what **Yehowah** has said, Here I am giving this city into the hand of the Chaldeans and into the hand of **Nebuchadrezzar** the **king** of **Babylon**, and he must capture it. (**Jeremiah 32:28**)
- In the ninth year of Zedekiah the **king** of Judah, in the tenth month, **Nebuchadrezzar** the **king** of **Babylon** and all his military force came to Jerusalem and began to lay siege to it. (**Jeremiah 39:1**)
- And it came about that while Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines themselves drew near for battle **against** Israel. And **Yehowah** now caused it to thunder with a loud noise on that day **against** the Philistines, that he might throw them into confusion, and they got defeated before Israel. (**1 Samuel 7:10**)
- And Asa began to call to **Yehowah** his God and say; O **Yehowah**, as to helping, it does not matter with you whether there are many or those with no power. Help us, O **Yehowah** our God, for upon you we do lean, and in your name we have come **against**

- this crowd. O **Yehowah**, you are our God. Do not let mortal man retain strength **against** you. (**2 Chronicles 14:11**)
- O God, with our ears we have heard, our forefather themselves have recounted to us the activity that you performed in their days, in the days of long ago. (**Psalms 44:1**)
 - Remember his **wonderful works** that he has performed, this miracles and the judicial decisions of his mouth. (**Psalms 105:5**)
 - Hence Sennacherib the **king** of Assyria pulled away and went and returned and took up dwelling in Nineveh. (**Isaiah 37:37**)
 - And their brothers the doers of the work of the house, eight hundred and twenty-two, and Adaiah the son of Jeroham the son of Pelaliah the son of Amzi the son of Zechariah the son of Pashhur the son of Malchijah. (**Nehemiah 11:12**)
 - For they have called themselves as being from the holy city, and upon the God of Israel they have supported themselves, **Yehowah** of armies being his name. (**Isaiah 48:2**)
 - And it kept on occurring in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, the **king** of Judah, until the completion of the eleventh year of Zedekiah the son of Josiah, the **king** of Judah, until Jerusalem went into exile in the fifth month. (**Jeremiah 1:3**)
 - And King Zedekiah proceeded to send Jehucal the son of Shelemiah and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah the priest to Jeremiah the prophet, saying; Pray, please, in our **behalf** to **Yehowah** our God. (**Jeremiah 37:3**)
 - This is what **Yehowah** the God of Israel has said, This is what **you** men should say to the **king** of Judah, the one sending **you** to me to **inquire** of me; Look! The military force of Pharaoh that is coming forth to **you** people for the purpose of assistance **will** have to go back to their land, Egypt. (**Jeremiah 37:7**)
 - There **will** come adversity upon adversity, and there **will** occur report upon report, and people **will** actually seek a vision from a prophet, and the Law itself **will** perish from a priest and counsel from elderly men. (**Ezekiel 7:26**)
 - For any man at all from the house of Israel or from the alien residents that reside as aliens in Israel, that **withdraws** himself from following me and that brings up his dungy idols upon his

heart and that sets the very stumbling block causing his error in front of his face and that actually comes to the prophet to make inquiry for himself by me, I, **Yehowah**, I am letting myself be brought to answer him by myself. (**Ezekiel 14:7**)
