

Jeremiah 21:4 **This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Here I am turning in reverse the weapons of war that are in the hand of you people, with which you are fighting the king of Babylon, and the Chaldeans who are laying siege against you outside the wall, and I will gather them into the middle of this city.**

- And to **Babylon** he **will** take Zedekiah, and there he **will** continue until I turn my attention to him, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, although **you** men keep warring **against** the **Chaldeans**, **you will** not succeed? (**Jeremiah 32:5**)
- Concerning those who are coming to fight **against** the **Chaldeans** and to fill places with the carcasses of the men whom I have struck down in my anger and in my rage, and on account of all whose badness I have concealed my face from this **city**. (**Jeremiah 33:5**)
- However, because our fathers irritated the **God** of the heavens, he gave them into the **hand** of Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of **Babylon**, the Chaldean, and he demolished this house and took the **people** into exile at **Babylon**. (**Ezra 5:12**)
- Listen! A crowd in the mountains, something like a numerous **people**! Listen! The uproar of kingdoms, of nations gathered together! **Yehowah** of armies is mustering the army of **war**. (**Isaiah 13:4**)
- Therefore here I **am** collecting together all those passionately loving you toward whom you were pleasurable and all those whom you loved along with all those whom you hated, and I **will** collect them together **against** you from all around and uncover your private parts to them, and they must see all your private parts. (**Ezekiel 16:37**)
- And the **city** got to be breached, and all the men of **war** fled by night by the way of the gate between the double **wall** that is by the king's garden, while the **Chaldeans** were all around **against** the **city**, and the **king** began to go in the direction of the Arabah. (**2 Kings 25:4**)
- Look! With **siege** ramparts men have come to the **city** to capture it, and the very **city will** certainly be given into the **hand** of the **Chaldeans** who are **fighting against** it, because of the sword and

- the famine and the pestilence, and **what** you have **said** has happened, and here you are seeing it. (**Jeremiah 32:24**)
- Therefore this is **what Yehowah has said**; Here I **am** giving this **city** into the **hand** of the **Chaldeans** and into the **hand** of Nebuchadrezzar the **king** of **Babylon**, and he must capture it. (**Jeremiah 32:28**)
 - And fields **will** certainly be bought in this land of which **you people will** be saying; It is a desolate waste without man and domestic animal. It **has** been given into the **hand** of the **Chaldeans**. (**Jeremiah 32:43**)
 - And **against** Jehoiakim the **king** of Judah you should say; This is **what Yehowah has said**; You yourself have burned up this roll, saying; Why is it that you have written on it, saying; The **king** of **Babylon will** come without fail and **will** certainly bring this land to ruin and cause man and beast to cease from it? (**Jeremiah 36:29**)
 - For if **you** men had struck down all the military force of the **Chaldeans** who are **fighting you** and there remained over among them men pierced through, they would each one in his tent rise up and actually burn this **city** with fire. (**Jeremiah 37:10**)
 - Because of the **Chaldeans**, for they had become afraid because of them, since Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had struck down Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the **king** of **Babylon** had commissioned over the land. (**Jeremiah 41:18**)
