Jeremiah 21:4" This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Here I am turning in reverse the weapons of war that are in the hand of you people, with which you are fighting the king of Babylon, and the Chaldeans who are laying siege against you outside the wall, and I will gather them into the middle of this city.

- And to Babylon he will take Zedekiah, and there he will continue until I turn my attention to him, is the utterance of Yehowah, although you men keep warring against the Chaldeans, you will not succeed? (Jeremiah 32:5)
- Concerning those who are coming to fight against the Chaldeans and to fill places with the carcasses of the men whom I have struck down in my anger and in my rage, and on account of all whose badness I have concealed my face from this city.

 (Jeremiah 33:5)
- However, because our fathers irritated the God of the heavens, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean, and he demolished this house and took the people into exile at Babylon. (Ezra 5:12)
- Listen! A crowd in the mountains, something like a numerous people! Listen! The uproar of kingdoms, of nations gathered together! Yehowah of armies is mustering the army of war. (Isaiah 13:4)
- Therefore here I am collecting together all those passionately loving you toward whom you were pleasurable and all those whom you loved along with all those whom you hated, and I will collect them together against you from all around and uncover your private parts to them, and they must see all your private parts. (Ezekiel 16:37)
- And the city got to be breached, and all the men of war fled by night by the way of the gate between the double wall that is by the king's garden, while the Chaldeans were all around against the city, and the king began to go in the direction of the Arabah. (2 Kings 25:4)
- Look! With siege ramparts men have come to the city to capture it, and the very city will certainly be given into the hand of the Chaldeans who are fighting against it, because of the sword and

- the famine and the pestilence, and what you have said has happened, and here you are seeing it. (Jeremiah 32:24)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am giving this city into the hand of the Chaldeans and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, and he must capture it. (Jeremiah 32:28)
- Pand fields will certainly be bought in this land of which you people will be saying; It is a desolate waste without man and domestic animal. It has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans. (Jeremiah 32:43)
- And against Jehoiakim the king of Judah you should say; This is what Yehowah has said; You yourself have burned up this roll, saying; Why is it that you have written on it, saying; The king of Babylon will come without fail and will certainly bring this land to ruin and cause man and beast to cease from it? (Jeremiah 36:29)
- For if you men had struck down all the military force of the Chaldeans who are fighting you and there remained over among them men pierced through, they would each one in his tent rise up and actually burn this city with fire. (Jeremiah 37:10)
- Because of the Chaldeans, for they had become afraid because of them, since Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had struck down Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the king of Babylon had commissioned over the land. (Jeremiah 41:18)
