Jeremiah 22:16. He pleaded the legal claim of the afflicted one and the poor one. In that case it went well. Was not that a case of knowing me? Is the utterance of Yehowah.

- For I would rescue the afflicted one crying for help, and the fatherless boy and anyone that had no helper. (Job 29:12)
- May he plead the cause of your people with righteousness and of your afflicted ones with judicial decision. (Psalms 72:2)
- Learn to do good, search for justice, set right the oppressor, render judgment for the fatherless boy, plead the cause of the widow. (Isaiah 1:17)
- Continue your loving-kindness to those knowing you, and your righteousness to those upright in heart. (Psalms 36:10)
