Jeremiah 22:17... Assuredly your eyes and your heart are upon nothing but upon your unjust gain, and upon the blood of the innocent one in order to shed it, and upon defrauding and upon extortion in order to carry them on.

- When I got to see among the spoil an official garment from Shinar, a good-looking one, and two hundred shekels of silver and one gold bar, fifty shekels being its weight, then I wanted them, and I took them, and, look! They are hidden in the earth in the midst of my tent with the money underneath it. (Joshua 7:21)
- For the wicked has praised himself over the selfish longing of his soul, and the one making undue profit has blessed himself he has disrespected Yehowah. (Psalms 10:3)
- Make my eyes pass on from seeing what is worthless; Preserve me alive in your own way. (Psalms 119:37)
- And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (2 Kings 24:4)
- And his sons did not walk in his ways, but they were inclined to follow unjust profit and would accept a bribe and pervert judgment. (1 Samuel 8:3)
- And it came about that, as soon as Jezebel heard that Naboth had been stoned so that he died, Jezebel immediately said to Ahab; Rise up, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give you for money, for Naboth is no longer alive, but dead. (1 Kings 21:15)
- He sits in an ambush of settlements, from concealed places he will kill someone innocent. His eyes are on the lookout for someone unfortunate. (Psalms 10:8)
- How much, rather, do you with the heart practice outright unrighteousness in the earth, and prepare the road for the very violence of your hands! (Psalms 58:2)
- Woe to the ones joining house to house, and those who annex field to field until there is no more room and you men have been

made to dwell all by yourselves in the midst of the land! (Isaiah 5:8)

- Their own feet keep running to sheer badness, and they are in a hurry to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are hurtful thoughts, despoiling and breakdown are in their highways. (Isaiah 59:7)
- Make the chain, for the land itself has become full of bloodstained judgment and the city itself has become full of violence. (Ezekiel 7:23)
- And he began to walk about in the midst of lions. A maned young lion is what he became. And he gradually learned how to tear apart prey. He devoured even earthling man. (Ezekiel 19:6)
- The fat is what you eat, and with the wool you clothe your own selves. The plump animal is what you slaughter. The flock itself you do not feed. (Ezekiel 34:3)
