

Jeremiah 22:2 And you must say; Hear the word of Yehowah, O king of Judah who are sitting on the throne of David, you with your servants and your people, those who are coming in through these gates.

[7] - References:

- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am filling all the inhabitants of this land and the kings that are sitting for David upon his throne and the priests and the prophets and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with drunkenness. (Jeremiah 13:13)
- There will also certainly enter in by the gates of this city kings with princes, sitting on the throne of David, riding in the chariot and upon horses, they and their princes, the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and this city will certainly be inhabited to time indefinite. (Jeremiah 17:25)
- This one will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and Yehowah God will give him the throne of David his father. (Luke 1:32)
- Stand in the gate of the house of Yehowah, and you must proclaim there this word, and you must say, Hear the word of Yehowah, all you of Judah, who are entering into these gates to bow down to Yehowah. (Jeremiah 7:2)
- And you must say to them, Hear the word of Yehowah, you kings of Judah and all Judah and all you inhabitants of Jerusalem, who are entering in by these gates. (Jeremiah 17:20)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to the king sitting on the throne of David and to all the people dwelling in this city, your brothers that have not gone forth with you into exile. (Jeremiah 29:16)
- And you yourself must enter in and read aloud from the roll that you have written at my mouth the words of Yehowah in the ears of the people at the house of Yehowah in the day of fast, and also in the ears of all Judah who are coming in from their cities you should read them aloud. (Jeremiah 36:6)
