

Jeremiah 22:4 **For if you will by all means perform this word, there will also certainly come in through the gates of this house the kings sitting for David upon his throne, riding in chariots and on horses, he with his servants and his people.**

[3] - References:

- All the while Elisha was seeing it, and he was crying out; My father, my father, the war chariot of Israel and his horsemen! And he did not see him anymore. Consequently he took hold of his own garments and ripped them into two pieces. (**2 Kings 2:12**)
- There **will** also **certainly** enter in by the **gates** of this city **kings** with princes, **sitting** on the **throne** of **David**, **riding** in the chariot and upon **horses**, they and their princes, the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and this city **will certainly** be inhabited to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 17:25**)
- Further, he took the chiefs of hundreds and the Carian bodyguard and the runners and all the people of the land, that they might bring the king down from the **house** of Yehowah, and they came gradually by the way of the gate of the runners to the king's **house**, and he began to sit upon the **throne** of the **kings**. (**2 Kings 11:19**)
