- Let me pass over, please, and see the good land that is across the Jordan, this good mountainous region and Lebanon. (**Deuteronomy 3:25**)
- Fruitful land into salt country, owing to the badness of those dwelling in it. (**Psalms 107:34**)
- For the fortified city **will** be solitary, the pasture ground **will** be left to itself and abandoned like a **wilderness**. There the calf **will** graze, and there it **will** lie down, and he **will** actually consume her boughs. (**Isaiah 27:10**)
- At this I **said**; How long, O Yehowah? Then he **said**; Until the **cities** actually crash in ruins, to be without an inhabitant, and the **houses** be without earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a desolation. (**Isaiah 6:11**)
- Look! **Yehowah** is emptying the land and laying it waste, and he **has** twisted the face of it and scattered its inhabitants. (**Isaiah 24:1**)
- And I **will** cause to cease from the **cities** of **Judah** and from the streets of Jerusalem the voice of exultation and the voice of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, for the land **will** become nothing but a devastated place. (**Jeremiah 7:34**)
- O you who are dwelling in **Lebanon**, being nested in the cedars, how you **will** certainly sigh when there come to you birth pangs, the labor pains like those of a woman giving birth! (**Jeremiah 22:23**)
- As I am alive, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, even if Coniah the son of Jehoiakim, the **king** of **Judah**, happened to be the seal ring on my right hand, from there I would pull you off! (**Jeremiah 22:24**)
