- And this house itself **will** become heaps of ruins. Everyone passing by it **will** stare in amazement and **will** certainly whistle and **say**, For **what** reason did **Yehowah** do like that to this land and this house? (**1 Kings 9:8**)
- At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept wagging their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the **city** of which they used to **say**; It is the perfection of prettiness, an exultation for all the earth? (**Lamentations 2:15**)
- Yes, all the **nations will** be bound to **say**, Why did **Yehowah** do like this to this land? Why the heat of this **great** anger? (**Deuteronomy 29:24**)
- As for this house that had become heaps of ruins, everyone passing by it **will** stare in amazement and be certain to **say**, For **what** reason did **Yehowah** do like that to this land and to this house? (**2 Chronicles 7:21**)
- And it must occur that, when you tell to this people all these words and they **actually say** to you, On **what account** has **Yehowah** spoken against us all this **great** calamity, and **what** is our error and **what** is our sin with which we have sinned against **Yehowah** our God? (**Jeremiah 16:10**)
