- Then they will **have to say**; It was because they abandoned the **covenant of Yehowah the God** of their forefathers, which he concluded with them when he brought them out of the land of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 29:25**)
- Not one like the **covenant** that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, which **covenant** of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 31:32**)
- And they **proceeded** to go and **serve** other **gods** and to **bow down** to them, **gods** that they had not known and he had not apportioned to them. (**Deuteronomy 29:26**)
- For I shall bring them to the ground that I **have** sworn about to their forefathers, which flows with milk and honey, and they will certainly eat and be satisfied and grow fat and turn to other **gods**, and they will indeed **serve** them and treat me with disrespect and break my **covenant**. (**Deuteronomy 31:20**)
- Due to the **fact** that they **have left** me and **have** gone making sacrificial smoke to other **gods** in order to offend me with all the work of their hands, and my rage has been set afire against this place and will not be extinguished. (**2 Kings 22:17**)
- Due to the **fact** that they **have left** me and gone making sacrificial smoke to other **gods**, in order to offend me with all the doings of their hands and that my rage may pour forth upon this place and not be extinguished. (**2 Chronicles 34:25**)
- To this he said; I **have** been absolutely jealous for **Yehowah the God** of armies, for the sons of Israel **have left** your **covenant**, your altars they **have torn down**, and your prophets they **have** killed with the sword, so that I only am **left**, and they begin looking for my soul to take it away. (**1 Kings 19:14**)

- And they will **have** to **say**; It was for the reason that they **left Yehowah** the **God** of their forefathers who had brought them out of the land of Egypt, and they **proceeded** to take hold of other **gods** and **bow down** to them and **serve** them. That is why he brought upon them all this calamity. (**2 Chronicles 7:22**)
- You must also **say** to them; On **account** of the **fact** that **YOUR** fathers **left** me, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and they kept going after other **gods** and serving them and bowing **down** to them. But me they **left**, and my Law they did not keep. (**Jeremiah 16:11**)
- It is because of their badness that they did in order to offend me by going and making sacrificial smoke and rendering service to other **gods** whom they themselves had not known, neither **YOU** nor **YOUR** forefathers. (**Jeremiah 44:3**)
- And they will certainly comfort **YOU** people when **YOU** see their way and their dealings, and **YOU** will **have** to know that it was not without cause that I shall **have** done all that I must do against her, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 14:23**)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said, I also must do with you just as you **have** done, because you despised the oath in breaking my **covenant**. (**Ezekiel 16:59**)
- And he has despised an oath in breaking a **covenant**, and, look! He had given his hand and has done even all these things. He will not make his escape. (**Ezekiel 17:18**)
- There will be a doing of these things to you because of your going like a prostitute after the nations, on **account** of the **fact** that you defiled yourself with their dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 23:30**)
- And the nations will **have** to know that it was because of their error that they, the house of Israel, went into exile, on **account** of the **fact** that they behaved unfaithfully toward me, so that I concealed my face from them and gave them into the hand of their adversaries, and they kept falling, all of them, by the sword. (**Ezekiel 39:23**)
