Jeremiah 23:12. Therefore their way will become for them like slippery places in the gloom, into which they will be pushed and certainly fall. For I shall bring upon them a calamity, the year of their being given attention, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- Let their way become darkness and slippery places, and let Yehowah's angel be pursuing them. (Psalms 35:6)
- Surely on slippery ground is where you place them. You have made them fall to ruins. (Psalms 73:18)
- The way of the wicked ones is like the gloom, they have not known at what they keep stumbling. (Proverbs 4:19)
- Give to Yehowah Your God glory, before he causes darkness and before Your feet strike up against each other on the mountains at dusk. And You will certainly hope for the light, and he will actually make it deep shadow, he will turn it into thick gloom.

  (Jeremiah 13:16)
- And it must occur that if you will not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (Deuteronomy 28:15)
- Did they feel shame because they had done even what was detestable? For one thing, they positively could not feel ashamed, for another thing, they did not know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling. In the time of their being given attention, they will stumble, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 8:12)
- And not even a remnant will there come to be for them, because I shall bring calamity upon the men of Anathoth, the year of their being given attention. (Jeremiah 11:23)
- And to the earth he will look, and, lo! Distress and darkness, obscurity, hard times and gloominess with no brightness. (Isaiah 8:22)
- And jackals must howl in her dwelling towers, and the big snake will be in the palaces of exquisite delight. And the season for her

is near to come, and her days themselves will not be postponed. (Isaiah 13:22)

- For Yehowah has a day of vengeance, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (Isaiah 34:8)
- Did they feel shame because it was something detestable that they had done? For one thing, they positively do not feel any shame, for another thing, they have not come to know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling, in the time that I must hold an accounting with them they will stumble, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 6:15)
- Massacre all her young bulls. May they go down to the slaughter.
   Woe to them, for their day has come, the time for their being given attention! (Jeremiah 50:27)
- These have the authority to shut up heaven that no rain should fall during the days of their prophesying, and they have authority over the waters to turn them into blood and to strike the earth with every sort of plague as often as they wish. (Revelation 11:6)
