

**Jeremiah 23:17** **They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me, Yehowah has spoken; Peace is what you people will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his heart they have said, No calamity will come upon you people.**

[17] - References:

- And I proceeded to say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Truly you **have** absolutely deceived this **people** and Jerusalem, saying, Peace itself **will** become **YOURS**, and the sword **has** reached clear to the soul. (**Jeremiah 4:10**)
- And they try to heal the breakdown of my **people** lightly, saying; There is peace! There is peace! When there is no peace. (**Jeremiah 6:14**)
- And they try to heal the breakdown of the daughter of my **people** lightly, saying; There is peace! There is peace! When there is no peace. (**Jeremiah 8:11**)
- For the reason, yes, for the reason that they **have** led my **people** astray, saying, There is peace! When there is no peace, and there is one that is building a partition wall, but in vain there are those plastering it with whitewash. (**Ezekiel 13:10**)
- And it must occur that when someone **has** heard the words of this oath, and he **has** blessed himself in his **heart**, saying; I shall **come to have** peace, although I shall walk in the **stubbornness** of my heart, with the intention of sweeping away the well-watered one along with the thirsty ones. (**Deuteronomy 29:19**)
- In that time they **will** call Jerusalem the throne of Yehowah, and to her all the nations must be brought together to the name of Yehowah at Jerusalem, and they **will** no more walk after the **stubbornness** of their bad heart. (**Jeremiah 3:17**)
- By the sword they **will** die, all the sinners of my **people**, those who are saying; The **calamity will** not **come** near or reach as far as us. (**Amos 9:10**)
- Her own head ones judge merely for a bribe, and her own priests instruct just for a price, and her own prophets practice divination simply for money, yet upon Yehowah they keep supporting

- themselves, saying; Is not Yehowah in the midst of us? There **will come** upon us no **calamity**. (**Micah 3:11**)
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and **said**; This is **what** Yehowah **has said**; With these you **will** push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (**1 Kings 22:11**)
  - Who **have said** to the ones seeing, **you** must not see, and to the ones having visions, **you** must not envision for us any straightforward things. Speak to us smooth things, envision deceptive things. (**Isaiah 30:10**)
  - They **have** denied Yehowah, and they keep saying; He is not. And upon us no **calamity will come**, and no sword or famine shall we see. (**Jeremiah 5:12**)
  - But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went **walking** in the counsels in the **stubbornness** of their bad **heart**, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. (**Jeremiah 7:24**)
  - For even your own brothers and the household of your own father, even they themselves **have** dealt treacherously with you. Even they themselves **have** called out loudly behind you. Do not put any faith in them, just because they speak to you good things. (**Jeremiah 12:6**)
  - At this I **said**; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Here the prophets are saying to them, **you will** see no sword, and there **will** be no famine to happen to **you**, but true peace is **what** I shall give **you** in this place. (**Jeremiah 14:13**)
  - And Hananiah went on to say before the eyes of all the **people**; This is **what** Yehowah **has said**, Just like this I shall break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon within two full years more from off the neck of all the nations. And Jeremiah the prophet proceeded to go his way. (**Jeremiah 28:11**)
  - Where, now, are **YOUR** prophets who prophesied to **you**, saying; The king of Babylon **will not come** against **you** men and against this land? (**Jeremiah 37:19**)
  - This is **what** Yehowah **has said** against the prophets that are causing my **people** to wander, that are biting with their teeth and that actually call out; Peace! That, when anyone does not put

**something into their mouths, also actually sanctify war against him. (Micah 3:5)**
