

**Jeremiah 23:19** Look! The windstorm of Yehowah, rage itself, will certainly go forth, even a whirling tempest. Upon the head of the wicked ones it will whirl itself.

[13] - References:

- That is why the anger of Yehowah has grown hot against his people, and he will stretch out his hand against them and strike them. And the mountains will be agitated, and their dead bodies will become like the offal in the midst of the streets. In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 5:25)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Look! A calamity is going forth from nation to nation, and a great tempest itself will be roused up from the remotest parts of the earth. (Jeremiah 25:32)
- And all the evil of the men of Shechem God made come back upon their own heads, that the malediction of Jotham the son of Jerubbaal might come upon them. (Judges 9:57)
- And David got to hear that Nabal had died, and so he said; Blessed be Yehowah, who has conducted the legal case of my reproach to free me from Nabal's hand and has kept his servant back from badness, and the badness of Nabal Yehowah has turned back upon his own head! And David proceeded to send and propose to Abigail to take her as his wife. (1 Samuel 25:39)
- Hear, O our God, for we have become an object of contempt, and make their reproach return upon their own head, and give them to the plunder in the land of captivity. (Nehemiah 4:4)
- Look! A windstorm of Yehowah, rage itself, has gone forth, an onward-sweeping tempest. Upon the head of the wicked ones it will whirl. (Jeremiah 30:23)
- Here I am arousing them to come from the place where YOU have sold them, and I will pay back YOUR treatment upon YOUR own heads. (Joel 3:7)
- For the day of Yehowah against all the nations is near. In the way that you have done, it will be done to you. Your sort of treatment will return upon your own head. (Obadiah 1:15)

- Before **YOUR** pots feel the kindled bramble, the live green as well as the burning, he **will** carry them off as a stormy wind. (**Psalms 58:9**)
- Never yet have they been planted, never yet have they been sown, never yet has their stump taken root in the earth. And one has only to blow upon them and they dry up, and like stubble the **windstorm** itself **will** carry them away. (**Isaiah 40:24**)
- You **will** winnow them, and a wind itself **will** carry them away, and a **windstorm** itself **will** drive them different ways. And you yourself **will** be joyful in **Yehowah**. In the Holy One of Israel you **will** boast about yourself. (**Isaiah 41:16**)
- Say to those plastering with whitewash that it **will** fall. A flooding downpour **will certainly** occur, and **you**, O hailstones, **will** fall, and a blast of **windstorms** itself **will** cause a splitting. (**Ezekiel 13:11**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said, I **will** also cause a blast of **windstorms** to burst forth in my **rage**, and in my anger there **will** occur a flooding downpour, and in **rage** there **will** be hailstones for an extermination. (**Ezekiel 13:13**)
