

Jeremiah 23:21· **I did not send the prophets, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied.**

[7] - References:

- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the **prophets** are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to **you** people. (**Jeremiah 14:14**)
- For I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah, but they are prophesying in my name falsely, to the end that I shall disperse **you**, and **you** will have to perish, **you** men and the **prophets** that are prophesying to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:15**)
- For it is in falsehood that they are prophesying to **you** in my name. I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 29:9**)
- And do not listen to the words of the **prophets** that are saying to **you** men, **you** will not serve the king of Babylon, because falsehood is what they are prophesying to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:14**)
- And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah has not sent you, but you yourself have caused this people to trust in a falsehood. (**Jeremiah 28:15**)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Let not **YOUR prophets** who are in among **you** and **YOUR** practicers of divination deceive **you**, and do not **you** listen to their dreams that they are dreaming. (**Jeremiah 29:8**)
- Send to all the exiled people, saying; This is what Yehowah has said concerning Shemaiah of Nehelam; For the reason that Shemaiah has **prophesied** to **you** people, but I myself did not send him, and he tried to make **you** trust in falsehood. (**Jeremiah 29:31**)
