Jeremiah 23:24... Or can any man¹ be concealed in places of concealment and I myself not see him? Is the utterance of Yehowah. Is it not the heavens and the earth that I myself actually fill? Is the utterance of Yehowah.

- But will God truly dwell upon the earth? Look! The heavens, yes, the heaven of the heavens, themselves cannot contain you, how much less, then, this house that I have built! (1 Kings 8:27)

- And your sitting quiet and your going out and your coming in I well know, and your exciting yourself against me. (2 Kings 19:27)
- There is no darkness nor any deep shadow for those practicing what is hurtful to conceal themselves there. (Job 34:22)
- As for God, he has looked down from heaven itself upon the sons of men, to see whether there exists anyone having insight, anyone seeking Yehowah. (Psalms 53:2)
- And were I to say; Surely darkness itself will hastily seize me! Then night would be light about me. (Psalms 139:11)
- For the ways of man are in front of the eyes of Yehowah, and he is contemplating all his tracks. (Proverbs 5:21)
- And your sitting quiet and your going out and your coming in I well know, and your exciting yourself against me. (Isaiah 37:28)
- And you kept trusting in your badness. You have said; There is no one seeing me. Your wisdom and your knowledge, this is what has led you away, and you keep saying in your heart; I am, and there is nobody else. (Isaiah 47:10)
- Has this house upon which my name has been called become a mere cave of robbers in Your eyes? Here I myself also have seen it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 7:11)
- For the reason that they have carried on senselessness in Israel, and they keep committing adultery with the wives of their companions and keep speaking falsely in my own name the word that I did not command them. And I am the One knowing and am a witness, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:23)
- But as for me, I will strip Esau bare. I will uncover his places of concealment, and one will not be able to hide oneself. His offspring and his brothers and his neighbors will certainly be despoiled, and he will not be. (Jeremiah 49:10)
- He now said to me; Son of man, bore, please, through the wall. And I gradually bored through the wall, and, look! There was a certain entrance. (Ezekiel 8:8)
- And if they hide themselves on the top of Carmel, from there I shall carefully search and be certain to take them. And if they

conceal themselves from in front of my eyes on the floor of the sea, down there I shall command the serpent, and it must bite them. (Amos 9:3)
