Jeremiah 23:25" I have heard what the prophets who are prophesying falsehood in my own name have said, saying; I have had a dream! I have had a dream!

- For the reason that they have carried on senselessness in Israel, and they keep committing adultery with the wives of their companions and keep speaking falsely in my own name the word that I did not command them. And I am the One knowing and am a witness, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:23)
- In case a prophet or a dreamer of a dream arises in your midst and does give you a sign or a portent. (Deuteronomy 13:1)
- However, the prophet who presumes to speak in my name a word that I have not commanded him to speak or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet must die. (Deuteronomy 18:20)
- And as for you men, do not listen to Your prophets and to Your practicers of divination and to Your dreamers and to Your practicers of magic and to Your sorcerers, who are saying to You; You men will not serve the king of Babylon. (Jeremiah 27:9)
- For the teraphim themselves have spoken what is uncanny, and the practicers of divination, for their part, have visioned falsehood, and valueless dreams are what they keep speaking, and in vain they try to comfort. That is why they will certainly depart like a flock, they will become afflicted, because there is no shepherd. (Zechariah 10:2)
- And all the other prophets were prophesying the same as that, saying; Go up to Ramoth-gilead and prove successful, and Yehowah will certainly give it into the king's hand. (2 Chronicles 18:11)
- And her prophets have plastered for them with whitewash, visioning an unreality and divining for them a lie, saying; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, when Yehowah himself has not spoken. (Ezekiel 22:28)
