

Jeremiah 23:26 How long will it exist in the heart of the prophets who are prophesying the falsehood and who are prophets of the trickiness of their own heart?**

[7] - References:

- And the sign or the portent does come true of which he spoke to you, saying; Let us walk after other gods, whom you have not known, and let us serve them. (**Deuteronomy 13:2**)
- But Elymas the sorcerer, that, in fact, is the way his name is translated, began opposing them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. (**Acts of Apostles 13:8**)
- So the sons of Israel did what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, and they were forgetful of Yehowah their God and went serving the Baals and the sacred poles. (**Judges 3:7**)
- So he built again the high places that Hezekiah his father had destroyed, and set up altars to Baal and made a sacred pole, just as Ahab the king of Israel had done, and he began to bow down to all the army of the heavens and to serve them. (**2 Kings 21:3**)
- You have tossed away all those straying from your regulations, for their **trickiness** is **falsehood**. (**Psalms 119:118**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the **prophets** are **prophesying** in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the **trickiness** of their **heart** they are speaking prophetically to **you** people. (**Jeremiah 14:14**)
- And in the **prophets** of Jerusalem I have seen horrible things, committing adultery and walking in **falsehood**, and they have strengthened the hands of evildoers in order that they should not return, each one from his **own** badness. To me all of them have become like Sodom, and the inhabitants of her like Gomorrah. (**Jeremiah 23:14**)
