Jeremiah 23:28... The prophet with whom there is a dream, let him relate the dream, but the one with whom my own word is, let him speak forth my word truthfully. What does the straw have to do with the grain? is the utterance of Yehowah.

- A faithful witness is one that will not lie, but a false witness launches forth mere lies. (Proverbs 14:5)
- And the Lord said; Who really is the faithful steward, the discreet one, whom his master will appoint over his body of attendants to keep giving them their measure of food supplies at the proper time? (Luke 12:42)
- We are, for we are not peddlers of the word of God as many men are, but as out of sincerity, yes, as sent from God, under God's view, in company with Christ, we are speaking. (2 Corinthians 2:17)
- You will winnow them, and a wind itself will carry them away, and a windstorm itself will drive them different ways. And you yourself will be joyful in Yehowah. In the Holy One of Israel you will boast about yourself. (Isaiah 41:16)
- His winnowing shovel is in his hand to clean up his threshing floor completely and to gather the wheat into his storehouse, but the chaff he will burn up with fire that cannot be put out. (Luke 3:17)
- Each one's work will become manifest, for the day will show it up, because it will be revealed by means of fire, and the fire itself will prove what sort of work each one's is. (1 Corinthians 3:13)
- And he went on to say; Hear my words, please. If there came to be a prophet of yours for Yehowah, it would be in a vision I would make myself known to him. In a dream I would speak to him. (Numbers 12:6)
- But Micaiah said; As Yehowah is living, what Yehowah will say to me, that is what I shall speak. (1 Kings 22:14)
- In turn she said to them; This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said, Say to the man that has sent you men to me. (2 Kings 22:15)

- But Micaiah said; As Yehowah is living, what my God will say, that is what I shall speak. (2 Chronicles 18:13)
