[7] - References:

- Look! The name of **Yehowah** is coming from far away, burning with his anger and with heavy clouds. As for his lips, they have become full of denunciation, and his tongue is like a devouring fire. (**Isaiah 30:27**)
- Therefore this is what **Yehowah**, the God of armies, has said; For the reason that **you** men are saying this thing, here I am making my **words** in your mouth a fire, and this people will be pieces of wood, and it will certainly devour them. (**Jeremiah 5:14**)
- And I said; I am not going to make mention of him, and I shall speak no more in his name. And in my heart it proved to be like a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I got tired of holding in, and I was unable to endure it. (**Jeremiah 20:9**)
- For the **word** of God is alive and exerts power and is sharper than any two-edged sword and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, and of joints and their marrow, and is able to discern thoughts and intentions of the heart. (**Hebrews 4:12**)
- How long, O **Yehowah**, will you keep yourself concealed? For all time? Will your rage keep on burning just like a fire? (**Psalms 89:46**)
- For because of the voice of **Yehowah** Assyria will be struck with terror, he will strike it even with a staff. (**Isaiah 30:31**)
- That is why I shall have to hew them by the prophets, I shall have to kill them by the sayings of my mouth. And the judgments upon you will be as the light that goes forth. (**Hosea 6:5**)
