

Jeremiah 23:3 **And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I will bring them back to their pasture ground, and they will certainly be fruitful and become many.**

[30] - References:

- Save us, O Yehowah our God, and collect us **together** from the nations to give thanks to your holy name, to speak exultingly in your praise. (**Psalms 106:47**)
- And it must occur in that day that Yehowah **will** again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the **remnant** of his people who **will** remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (**Isaiah 11:11**)
- And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah **will** return and **certainly** come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite **will** be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they **will** attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
- And I **will** let myself be found by **you**, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I **will** gather **your** body of captives and collect **you together out** of all the nations and **out** of all the places to which I have **dispersed you**, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I **will bring you back** to the place from which I caused **you** to go into exile. (**Jeremiah 29:14**)
- Here I am bringing them from the land of the north, and I **will** collect them **together** from the remotest parts of the earth. Among them **will** be the blind and the lame, the pregnant woman and the one giving birth, all **together**. As a great congregation they **will** return here. (**Jeremiah 31:8**)
- I **will** whistle for them and collect them **together**, for I shall **certainly** redeem them, and they must **become many**, just like those who have **become many**. (**Zechariah 10:8**)
- Yehowah your God must also **bring back** your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)

- And Sharon must **become** a **pasture ground** for **sheep** and the low plain of Achor a resting-place for cattle, for my people who **will** have looked for me. (**Isaiah 65:10**)
- And I **will bring** Israel **back** to his **pasture ground**, and he **will certainly** graze on Carmel and on Bashan, and in the mountainous region of Ephraim and of Gilead his soul **will** be satisfied. (**Jeremiah 50:19**)
- And I **will bring** them **out** from the peoples and collect them **together** from the **lands** and **bring** them in onto their soil and feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the streambeds and by all the dwelling places of the land. (**Ezekiel 34:13**)
- In a good pasturage I shall feed them, and on Israel's high mountains their abiding place **will** come to be. There they **will** lie down in a good abiding place, and on a fat pasturage they **will** feed upon the mountains of Israel. (**Ezekiel 34:14**)
- I shall positively gather Jacob, all of you, I shall without fail collect the remaining ones of Israel **together**. In unity I shall set them, like a flock in the pen, like a drove in the midst of its **pasture**, they **will** be noisy with men. (**Micah 2:12**)
- Yehowah your God **will** indeed **bring** you into the land of which your fathers took possession, and you **will certainly** take possession of it, and he **will** indeed do you good and multiply you more than your fathers. (**Deuteronomy 30:5**)
- And I **will** gather **back** the captive ones of my people Israel, and they **will** actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- The entire congregation as one group was forty-two thousand three hundred and sixty. (**Ezra 2:64**)
- Yehowah is my Shepherd. I shall lack nothing. (**Psalms 23:1**)
- Return, O **you** renegade sons, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I myself have **become** the husbandly owner of **you** people, and I **will** take **you**, one **out** of a city and two **out** of a family, and I **will bring you** to Zion. (**Jeremiah 3:14**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; **CRY out** loudly to Jacob with rejoicing, and **CRY** shrilly at the head of nations. **PUBLISH** it. **GIVE**

- praise and **SAY**, Save, O Yehowah, your people, the **remnant** of Israel. (**Jeremiah 31:7**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Hold **back** your voice from weeping, and your eyes from tears, for there exists a reward for your activity, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they **will certainly** return from the land of the enemy. (**Jeremiah 31:16**)
 - Here I am collecting them **together out** of all the **lands** to which I shall have **dispersed** them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I **will bring** them **back** to this place and make them dwell in security. (**Jeremiah 32:37**)
 - And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob **will certainly** return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 46:27**)
 - Because of the restful odor I shall take pleasure in **you**, when I **bring you** forth from the peoples and I actually collect **you together** from the **lands** to which **you** have been scattered, and I **will** be sanctified in **you** before the eyes of the nations. (**Ezekiel 20:41**)
 - And I **will** save my **sheep**, and they **will** no longer **become** something for plunder, and I **will** judge between a **sheep** and a **sheep**. (**Ezekiel 34:22**)
 - And I **will** take **you out** of the nations and collect **you together out** of all the **lands** and **bring you** in upon **YOUR** soil. (**Ezekiel 36:24**)
 - And speak to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am taking the sons of Israel from among the nations to which they have gone, and I **will** collect them **together** from round about and **bring** them onto their soil. (**Ezekiel 37:21**)
 - Who is a God like you, one pardoning error and passing over transgression of the **remnant** of his inheritance? He **will certainly** not hold onto his anger forever, for he is delighting in loving-kindness. (**Micah 7:18**)
 - And it must **become** a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they **will** feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they **will** lie stretched **out**. For Yehowah their

God **will** turn his attention to them and **certainly** gather **back** the captive ones of them. (**Zephaniah 2:7**)

- The ones grief-stricken in absence from your festal season I shall **certainly** gather **together**, absent from you they happened to be, because of bearing reproach on her account. (**Zephaniah 3:18**)
- Nevertheless, you do have a few names in Sardis that did not defile their outer garments, and they shall walk with me in white ones, because they are worthy. (**Revelation 3:4**)
- But right away the angel took the incense vessel, and he filled it with some of the fire of the altar and hurled it to the earth. And thunders occurred and voices and lightnings and an earthquake. (**Revelation 8:5**)
