Jeremiah 23:3... And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I will bring them back to their pasture ground, and they will certainly be fruitful and become many.

- Save us, O Yehowah our God, and collect us together from the nations to give thanks to your holy name, to speak exultingly in your praise. (Psalms 106:47)
- And it must occur in that day that Yehowah will again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the remnant of his people who will remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (Isaiah 11:11)
- And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah will return and certainly come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (Isaiah 35:10)
- And I will let myself be found by You, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will gather Your body of captives and collect You together out of all the nations and out of all the places to which I have dispersed You, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will bring You back to the place from which I caused You to go into exile. (Jeremiah 29:14)
- Here I am bringing them from the land of the north, and I will collect them together from the remotest parts of the earth. Among them will be the blind and the lame, the pregnant woman and the one giving birth, all together. As a great congregation they will return here. (Jeremiah 31:8)
- I will whistle for them and collect them together, for I shall certainly redeem them, and they must become many, just like those who have become many. (Zechariah 10:8)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)

- And Sharon must become a pasture ground for sheep and the low plain of Achor a resting-place for cattle, for my people who will have looked for me. (Isaiah 65:10)
- And I will bring Israel back to his pasture ground, and he will certainly graze on Carmel and on Bashan, and in the mountainous region of Ephraim and of Gilead his soul will be satisfied. (Jeremiah 50:19)
- And I will bring them out from the peoples and collect them together from the lands and bring them in onto their soil and feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the streambeds and by all the dwelling places of the land. (Ezekiel 34:13)
- In a good pasturage I shall feed them, and on Israel's high mountains their abiding place will come to be. There they will lie down in a good abiding place, and on a fat pasturage they will feed upon the mountains of Israel. (Ezekiel 34:14)
- I shall positively gather Jacob, all of you, I shall without fail collect the remaining ones of Israel together. In unity I shall set them, like a flock in the pen, like a drove in the midst of its pasture, they will be noisy with men. (Micah 2:12)
- Yehowah your God will indeed bring you into the land of which your fathers took possession, and you will certainly take possession of it, and he will indeed do you good and multiply you more than your fathers. (Deuteronomy 30:5)
- And I will gather back the captive ones of my people Israel, and they will actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (Amos 9:14)
- The entire congregation as one group was forty-two thousand three hundred and sixty. (Ezra 2:64)
- Yehowah is my Shepherd. I shall lack nothing. (Psalms 23:1)
- Return, O you renegade sons, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I myself have become the husbandly owner of you people, and I will take you, one out of a city and two out of a family, and I will bring you to Zion. (Jeremiah 3:14)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; CRY out loudly to Jacob with rejoicing, and CRY shrilly at the head of nations. Publish it. GIVE

- praise and SAY, Save, O Yehowah, your people, the remnant of Israel. (Jeremiah 31:7)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Hold back your voice from weeping, and your eyes from tears, for there exists a reward for your activity, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly return from the land of the enemy. (Jeremiah 31:16)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall have dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I will bring them back to this place and make them dwell in security. (Jeremiah 32:37)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (Jeremiah 46:27)
- Because of the restful odor I shall take pleasure in You, when I bring You forth from the peoples and I actually collect You together from the lands to which You have been scattered, and I will be sanctified in You before the eyes of the nations. (Ezekiel 20:41)
- And I will save my sheep, and they will no longer become something for plunder, and I will judge between a sheep and a sheep. (Ezekiel 34:22)
- And I will take you out of the nations and collect you together out of all the lands and bring you in upon your soil. (Ezekiel 36:24)
- And speak to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am taking the sons of Israel from among the nations to which they have gone, and I will collect them together from round about and bring them onto their soil. (Ezekiel 37:21)
- Who is a God like you, one pardoning error and passing over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He will certainly not hold onto his anger forever, for he is delighting in loving-kindness. (Micah 7:18)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they will feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they will lie stretched out. For Yehowah their

God will turn his attention to them and certainly gather back the captive ones of them. (Zephaniah 2:7)

- The ones grief-stricken in absence from your festal season I shall certainly gather together, absent from you they happened to be, because of bearing reproach on her account. (Zephaniah 3:18)
- Nevertheless, you do have a few names in Sardis that did not defile their outer garments, and they shall walk with me in white ones, because they are worthy. (Revelation 3:4)
- But right away the angel took the incense vessel, and he filled it with some of the fire of the altar and hurled it to the earth. And thunders occurred and voices and lightnings and an earthquake. (Revelation 8:5)
