- And **Judah** and **Israel** continued to dwell in **security**, everyone under his own vine and under his own fig tree, from Dan to Beer-sheba, all the days of Solomon. (**1 Kings 4:25**)
- But to the house of **Judah** I shall show mercy, and I **will** save them by **Yehowah** their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (**Hosea 1:7**)
- And I **will** make the house of **Judah** superior, and the house of Joseph I shall save. And I **will** give them a dwelling, for I **will** show them mercy, and they must become like those whom I had not cast off, for I am **Yehowah** their God, and I shall answer them. (**Zechariah 10:6**)
- And **Israel will reside in security**, the fountain of Jacob by itself, upon a land of grain and new wine. Yes, his heavens **will** let the dew drip down. (**Deuteronomy 33:28**)
- Let **Israel** keep waiting for **Yehowah**. For there is loving-kindness with **Yehowah**, and abundantly so is there redemption with him. (**Psalms 130:7**)
- No more **will** you be said to be a woman left entirely, and your own land **will** no more be said to be desolate, but you yourself **will** be called **My Delight Is In Her**, and your land **Owned As A Wife**. For **Yehowah will** have taken delight in you, and your own land **will** be owned as a wife. (**Isaiah 62:4**)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall have dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I **will** bring them back to this place and make them dwell in **security**. (**Jeremiah 32:37**)
- And people **will** certainly inhabit her, and there **will** occur no more any banning to destruction, and Jerusalem must be inhabited in **security**. (**Zechariah 14:11**)

- Any weapon whatever that **will** be formed against you **will** have no success, and any tongue at all that **will** rise up against you in the judgment you **will** condemn. This is the hereditary possession of the servants of **Yehowah**, and their righteousness is from me, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Isaiah 54:17**)
- In those days **Judah will** be **saved** and Jerusalem itself **will reside** in **security**. And this is what she **will** be **called**, **Yehowah** Is Our Righteousness. (**Jeremiah 33:16**)
- And **YOUR** threshing **will** certainly reach to **YOUR** grape gathering, and the grape gathering **will** reach to the sowing of seed, and **YOU will** indeed eat **YOUR** bread to satisfaction and dwell in **security** in **YOUR** land. (**Leviticus 26:5**)
- When I call, answer me, O my righteous God. In the distress you must make broad space for me. Show me favor and hear my prayer. (**Psalms 4:1**)
- And my people must dwell in a peaceful abiding place and in residences of full confidence and in undisturbed resting-places. (**Isaiah 32:18**)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O **Israel**. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob **will** certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 46:27**)
- And they **will** actually dwell upon it in **security** and build houses and plant vineyards, and they must dwell in **security** when I execute acts of judgment upon all those treating them with scorn all round about them, and they **will** have to know that I am **Yehowah** their God. (**Ezekiel 28:26**)
- And I **will** conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall certainly cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the land, and they **will** actually dwell in the wilderness in **security** and sleep in the forests. (**Ezekiel 34:25**)
- After many days you **will** be given attention. In the final part of the years you **will** come to the land of people brought back from the sword, collected together out of many peoples, onto the mountains of **Israel**, that have proved to be a constantly devastated place, even a land that has been brought forth from

- the peoples, where they have dwelt in **security**, all of them. (**Ezekiel 38:8**)
- And they **will** have borne their humiliation and all their unfaithfulness with which they have acted toward me, when they dwell on their soil in **security**, with no one to make them tremble. (**Ezekiel 39:26**)
 - And for them I shall certainly conclude a covenant in that day in connection with the wild beast of the field and with the flying creature of the heavens and the creeping thing of the ground, and the bow and the sword and war I shall break out of the land, and I **will** make them lie down in **security**. (**Hosea 2:18**)
 - Like a bird they **will** come trembling out of Egypt, and like a dove out of the land of Assyria, and I shall certainly make them dwell in their houses, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Hosea 11:11**)
 - And he **will** certainly stand and do shepherding in the strength of **Yehowah**, in the superiority of the **name** of **Yehowah** his God. And they **will** certainly keep dwelling, for now he **will** be great as far as the ends of the earth. (**Micah 5:4**)
 - In that day **Yehowah will** be a defense around the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and the one that is stumbling among them must become in that day like David, and the house of David like God, like Yehowah's angel before them. (**Zechariah 12:8**)
