Jeremiah 23:6" In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel itself will reside in security. And this is his name with which he will be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness.1

- And Judah and Israel continued to dwell in security, everyone under his own vine and under his own fig tree, from Dan to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon. (1 Kings 4:25)
- But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I will save them by Yehowah their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (Hosea 1:7)
- And I will make the house of Judah superior, and the house of Joseph I shall save. And I will give them a dwelling, for I will show them mercy, and they must become like those whom I had not cast off, for I am Yehowah their God, and I shall answer them. (Zechariah 10:6)
- And Israel will reside in security, the fountain of Jacob by itself, upon a land of grain and new wine. Yes, his heavens will let the dew drip down. (Deuteronomy 33:28)
- Let Israel keep waiting for Yehowah. For there is loving-kindness with Yehowah, and abundantly so is there redemption with him. (Psalms 130:7)
- No more will you be said to be a woman left entirely, and your own land will no more be said to be desolate, but you yourself will be called My Delight Is In Her, and your land Owned As A Wife. For Yehowah will have taken delight in you, and your own land will be owned as a wife. (Isaiah 62:4)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall have dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I will bring them back to this place and make them dwell in security. (Jeremiah 32:37)
- And people will certainly inhabit her, and there will occur no more any banning to destruction, and Jerusalem must be inhabited in security. (Zechariah 14:11)

- Any weapon whatever that will be formed against you will have no success, and any tongue at all that will rise up against you in the judgment you will condemn. This is the hereditary possession of the servants of Yehowah, and their righteousness is from me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Isaiah 54:17)
- In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem itself will reside in security. And this is what she will be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (Jeremiah 33:16)
- And YOUR threshing will certainly reach to YOUR grape gathering, and the grape gathering will reach to the sowing of seed, and YOU will indeed eat YOUR bread to satisfaction and dwell in security in YOUR land. (Leviticus 26:5)
- When I call, answer me, O my righteous God. In the distress you must make broad space for me. Show me favor and hear my prayer. (Psalms 4:1)
- And my people must dwell in a peaceful abiding place and in residences of full confidence and in undisturbed resting-places. (Isaiah 32:18)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (Jeremiah 46:27)
- And they will actually dwell upon it in security and build houses and plant vineyards, and they must dwell in security when I execute acts of judgment upon all those treating them with scorn all round about them, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah their God. (Ezekiel 28:26)
- And I will conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall certainly cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the land, and they will actually dwell in the wilderness in security and sleep in the forests. (Ezekiel 34:25)
- After many days you will be given attention. In the final part of the years you will come to the land of people brought back from the sword, collected together out of many peoples, onto the mountains of Israel, that have proved to be a constantly devastated place, even a land that has been brought forth from

the peoples, where they have dwelt in security, all of them. (Ezekiel 38:8)

- And they will have borne their humiliation and all their unfaithfulness with which they have acted toward me, when they dwell on their soil in security, with no one to make them tremble. (Ezekiel 39:26)
- And for them I shall certainly conclude a covenant in that day in connection with the wild beast of the field and with the flying creature of the heavens and the creeping thing of the ground, and the bow and the sword and war I shall break out of the land, and I will make them lie down in security. (Hosea 2:18)
- Like a bird they will come trembling out of Egypt, and like a dove out of the land of Assyria, and I shall certainly make them dwell in their houses, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Hosea 11:11)
- And he will certainly stand and do shepherding in the strength of Yehowah, in the superiority of the name of Yehowah his God. And they will certainly keep dwelling, for now he will be great as far as the ends of the earth. (Micah 5:4)
- In that day Yehowah will be a defense around the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and the one that is stumbling among them must become in that day like David, and the house of David like God, like Yehowah's angel before them. (Zechariah 12:8)
