Jeremiah 24:10... And I will send against them the sword, the famine and the pestilence, until they come to their finish off the ground that I gave to them and to their forefathers.

[19] - References:

- And You I shall scatter among the nations, and I will unsheathe a sword after You, and Your land must become a desolation, and Your cities will become a desolate ruin. (Leviticus 26:33)
- And I will scatter them among the nations that neither they nor their fathers have known, and I will send after them the sword until I shall have exterminated them. (Jeremiah 9:16)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said concerning the prophets who are prophesying in my name and whom I myself did not send and who are saying that no sword or famine will occur in this land; By sword and by famine those prophets will come to their finish. (Jeremiah 14:15)
- And it must occur that should they say to you; Where shall we go out to? You must also say to them; This is what Yehowah has said; Whoever is for deadly plague, to deadly plague! And whoever is for the sword, to the sword! And whoever is for the famine, to the famine! And whoever is for the captivity, to the captivity! (Jeremiah 15:2)
- Yehowah also will certainly make your plagues and the plagues of your offspring especially severe, great and long-lasting plagues, and malignant and long-lasting sicknesses.

 (Deuteronomy 28:59)
- The sword is outside, and the pestilence and the famine are inside. Whoever is in the field, by the sword he will die, and whoever are in the city, famine and pestilence themselves will devour them. (Ezekiel 7:15)
- And it must occur that just as Yehowah exulted over you to do you good and to multiply you, so Yehowah will exult over you to destroy you and to annihilate you, and you will simply be torn away from off the soil to which you are going to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 28:63)
- And I shall certainly bring upon You a sword wreaking vengeance for the covenant, and You will indeed gather yourselves into Your

- cities, and I shall certainly send pestilence into the midst of You, and You must be given into the hand of an enemy. (Leviticus 26:25)
- Yehowah will cause the pestilence to cling to you until he has exterminated you from off the ground to which you are going to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 28:21)
- And all these maledictions will certainly come upon you and pursue you and overtake you until you have been annihilated, because you did not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by keeping his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. (Deuteronomy 28:45)
- And it must occur that the nation and the kingdom that will not serve him, even Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and the one that will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, with the sword and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah, until I shall have finished them off by his hand. (Jeremiah 27:8)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Here I am sending against them the sword, the famine and the pestilence, and I will make them like the burst-open figs that cannot be eaten for badness. (Jeremiah 29:17)
- And I will pursue after them with the sword, with the famine and with the pestilence, and I will give them for a quaking to all the kingdoms of the earth, for a curse and for an object of astonishment and for a whistling at and for a reproach among all the nations to which I shall certainly disperse them. (Jeremiah 29:18)
- Look! With siege ramparts men have come to the city to capture it, and the very city will certainly be given into the hand of the Chaldeans who are fighting against it, because of the sword and the famine and the pestilence, and what you have said has happened, and here you are seeing it. (Jeremiah 32:24)
- And now, therefore, this is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said concerning this city which you persons are saying will certainly be given into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword and by the famine and by the pestilence. (Jeremiah 32:36)

- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said, you yourselves have not obeyed me in keeping on proclaiming liberty each one to his brother and each one to his companion. Here I am proclaiming to you a liberty, is the utterance of Yehowah, to the sword, to the pestilence and to the famine, and I shall certainly give you for a quaking to all the kingdoms of the earth. (Jeremiah 34:17)
- And it will come about that all the men that have set their faces to enter into Egypt to reside there as aliens will be the ones to die by the sword, by the famine and by the pestilence, and they will not come to have a survivor or an escapee, because of the calamity that I am bringing in upon them. (Jeremiah 42:17)
- And I will hold an accounting against those dwelling in the land of Egypt, just as I held an accounting against Jerusalem, with the sword, with the famine and with the pestilence. (Jeremiah 44:13)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Clap your hands and stamp with your foot, and say; Alas! On account of all the bad detestable things of the house of Israel, because by the sword, by the famine and by the pestilence they will fall. (Ezekiel 6:11)
