- And all this **land** must become a devastated **place**, an object of astonishment, and these nations **will** have to serve the king of Babylon seventy years. (**Jeremiah 25:11**)
- For this is **what Yehowah has said**; In accord with the fulfilling of seventy years at Babylon I shall turn my attention to **you** people, and I **will** establish toward **you** my **good** word in bringing **you** back to this **place**. (**Jeremiah 29:10**)
- This is **what Yehowah** of armies, the **God of Israel**, **has said** to all the exiled people, whom I have caused to go into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon. (**Jeremiah 29:4**)
- And as for **you**, hear the word of **Yehowah**, all you exiled people, whom I have sent **away** from Jerusalem to Babylon. (**Jeremiah 29:20**)
- Therefore say; This is **what** the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah has said**; Although I have put them far **away** among the nations, and although I have scattered them among the **lands**, yet I shall become to them a sanctuary for a little while among the **lands** to which they have come. (**Ezekiel 11:16**)
- And I shall certainly spread my net over him, and he must be caught in my hunting net, and I **will** bring him to Babylon, to the **land of the Chaldeans**, but it he **will** not see, and there he **will** die. (**Ezekiel 12:13**)
