

**Jeremiah 24:7<sup>••</sup> And I will give them a heart to know me, that I am Yehowah, and they must become my people, and I myself shall become their God, for they will return to me with all their heart.**

- And **Yehowah** your **God will** have to circumcise your **heart** and the **heart** of your offspring, that you may love **Yehowah** your **God** with all your **heart** and all your soul for the sake of your life. (**Deuteronomy 30:6**)
- For this is the covenant that I shall conclude with the house of Israel after those days, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. I **will** put my Law within them, and in their **heart** I shall write it. And I **will become** their **God**, and they themselves **will become** my **people**. (**Jeremiah 31:33**)
- And I **will give** them one **heart**, and a new spirit I shall put inside them, and I shall certainly remove the **heart** of stone from their flesh and **give** them a **heart** of flesh. (**Ezekiel 11:19**)
- And **you will** certainly **become** my **people**, and I myself shall **become** **YOUR God**. (**Jeremiah 30:22**)
- And they **will** certainly **become** my **people**, and I myself shall **become** their **God**. (**Jeremiah 32:38**)
- In order that those of the house of Israel may no more go wandering off from following me and may no more go defiling themselves with all their transgressions. And they **must become** my **people** and I myself shall **become** their God, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 14:11**)
- And I shall certainly bring them in, and they **must** reside in the midst of Jerusalem, and they **must become** my **people**, and I myself shall **become** their **God** in trueness and in righteousness. (**Zechariah 8:8**)
- For this is the covenant that I shall covenant with the house of Israel after those days, says **Yehowah**. I **will** put my Laws in their mind, and in their **hearts** I shall write them. And I **will become** their **God**, and they themselves **will become** my **people**. (**Hebrews 8:10**)

- And they indeed **return** to you with all their **heart** and with all their soul in the land of their enemies who carried them off captive, and they indeed pray to you in the direction of their land that you gave to their forefathers, the city that you have chosen and the house that I have built to your name. (**1 Kings 8:48**)
- And **you will** actually seek me and find me, for **you will** search for me with all **your heart**. (**Jeremiah 29:13**)
- And his majestic one **will** certainly come to be from him, and from the midst of him his own ruler **will** go forth, and I **will** cause him to come near, and he **must** approach to me. For who, now, is this one that has given his **heart** in pledge in order to approach to me? Is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 30:21**)
- And they **will** no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying, **Know** Yehowah! For they **will** all of them **know** me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)
- And **you people will** have to **know** that I **am Yehowah**, when I bring **you** onto the soil of Israel, into the land that I lifted up my hand in an oath to **give** to **your** forefathers. (**Ezekiel 20:42**)
- And those of the house of Israel **will** have to **know** that I **am Yehowah** their **God** from that day and forward. (**Ezekiel 39:22**)
- And I **will** engage you to me in faithfulness, and you **will** certainly **know** Yehowah. (**Hosea 2:20**)
- And we **will know**, we **will** pursue to **know Yehowah**. Like dawn, his going forth is firmly established. And he **will** come in like a pouring rain to us, like a spring rain that saturates the earth. (**Hosea 6:3**)
