

Jeremiah 25:12 And it must occur that when seventy years have been fulfilled I shall call to account against the king of Babylon and against that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah, their error, even against the land of the Chaldeans, and I will make it desolate wastes to time indefinite.

- **Yehowah** your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where **Yehowah** your God has scattered you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)
- And in the first year of Cyrus the **king** of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, **Yehowah** roused the spirit of Cyrus the **king** of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, saying; (**Ezra 1:1**)
- For this is what **Yehowah** has said; In accord with the fulfilling of **seventy years** at **Babylon** I shall turn my attention to **you** people, and I **will** establish toward **you** my good word in bringing **you** back to this place. (**Jeremiah 29:10**)
- The pronouncement **against Babylon** that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw in vision! (**Isaiah 13:1**)
- That you must raise up this proverbial saying **against** the **king** of **Babylon** and say; How has the one driving others to work come to a stop, the oppression come to a stop! (**Isaiah 14:4**)
- Come down and sit down in the dust, O virgin daughter of **Babylon**. Sit down on the earth where there is no throne, O daughter of the **Chaldeans**. For you **will** not experience again that people **call** you delicate and dainty. (**Isaiah 47:1**)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said; Here I am rousing up **against Babylon** and **against** the inhabitants of Leb-kamai a ruinous wind. (**Jeremiah 51:1**)
- This is the interpretation of the word; **MENE**, God has numbered the days of your kingdom and has finished it. (**Daniel 5:26**)
- In that very night Belshazzar the Chaldean **king** was killed. (**Daniel 5:30**)

- In his days Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of **Babylon** came up, and so Jehoiakim became his servant for three **years**. However, he turned back and rebelled **against** him. (**2 Kings 24:1**)
- And **Babylon**, the decoration of kingdoms, the beauty of the pride of the **Chaldeans**, must become as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah. (**Isaiah 13:19**)
- And I **will make** her a possession of porcupines and reedy pools of water, and I **will** sweep her with the broom of annihilation, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah** of armies. (**Isaiah 14:23**)
- And **Yehowah** your God **will** certainly put all these oaths upon your enemies and those who hate you, who **have** persecuted you. (**Deuteronomy 30:7**)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the **land** had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill **seventy years**. (**2 Chronicles 36:21**)
- O daughter of **Babylon**, who are to be despoiled, happy **will** he be that rewards you with your own treatment with which you treated us. (**Psalms 137:8**)
- The one striking peoples in fury with a stroke incessantly, the one subduing nations in sheer anger with a persecution without restraint. (**Isaiah 14:6**)
- He has left his covert just like a maned young lion, for their **land** has become an object of astonishment because of the maltreating sword and because of his burning anger. (**Jeremiah 25:38**)
- And all the nations must serve **even** him and his son and his grandson until the time **even** of his own **land** comes, and many nations and great **kings** must exploit him as a servant. (**Jeremiah 27:7**)
- Therefore all those devouring you **will** themselves be devoured, and as for all your adversaries, into captivity they **will** all of them go. And those pillaging you **will** certainly come to be for pillaging, and all those plundering you I shall give over to plundering. (**Jeremiah 30:16**)

- And Chaldea must become a spoil. All those making spoil of her **will** satisfy themselves, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 50:10**)
- Because of the indignation of **Yehowah** she **will** not be inhabited, and she must become a **desolate** waste in her entirety. As for anyone passing along by **Babylon**, he **will** stare in astonishment and whistle on **account** of all her plagues. (**Jeremiah 50:13**)
- Therefore the haunters of waterless regions **will** dwell with the howling animals, and in her the ostriches must dwell, and she **will** nevermore be dwelt in, nor **will** she reside for generation after generation. (**Jeremiah 50:39**)
- And they must fall slain in the **land** of the **Chaldeans** and pierced through in her streets. (**Jeremiah 51:4**)
- And **Babylon** must become piles of stones, the lair of jackals, an object of astonishment and something to whistle at, without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 51:37**)
- So the angel of **Yehowah** answered and said; O **Yehowah** of armies, how long **will** you yourself not show mercy to Jerusalem and to the cities of Judah, whom you **have** denounced these **seventy** years? (**Zechariah 1:12**)
