Footnote: Sheshach MVg, T, Babel This appears to be a cryptographic name for Babel (Babylon) by the device called 'ath·bash' that disguises the true name by taking the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet, Taw, for the first, 'A'leph, and the second to the last letter, Shin, for the second letter, Behth, and so on Thus in Babel each Behth, b would stand for Shin, La'medh would stand for Kaph, and the name would become She·shakh'
