- And I kept stamping down peoples in my anger, and I proceeded to make them **drunk** with my rage and to bring down to the earth their spurting blood. (**Isaiah 63:6**)
- Exult and rejoice, O daughter of Edom, dwelling as you do in the land of Uz. To you also the cup will pass along. You will become **drunk** and show yourself in nakedness. (**Lamentations 4:21**)
- You will certainly be satiated with dishonor instead of glory. Drink also, you yourself, and be considered uncircumcised. The cup of the right hand of **Yehowah** will come around to you, and there will be disgrace upon your glory. (**Habakkuk 2:16**)
- In order that I may actually cut off from you righteous one and wicked one, therefore my **sword** will go forth from its sheath against all flesh from south to north. (**Ezekiel 21:4**)
- Linger, **you** men, and be amazed, blind yourselves, and be blinded. They have become intoxicated, but not with wine, they have moved unsteadily, but not because of intoxicating liquor. (**Isaiah 29:9**)
- And you must **say** to them; **This is what Yehowah has said**; Here I **am** filling all the inhabitants of this land and the kings that are sitting for David upon his throne and the priests and the prophets and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with drunkenness. (**Jeremiah 13:13**)
- And I will dash them one against another, both the fathers and the sons, at the same time, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. I shall show no compassion, nor feel any sorrow, and I shall not have the mercy to keep from bringing them to ruin. (**Jeremiah 13:14**)
- When they are heated I shall set their banquets and I will make them **drunk**, in order that they may exult, and they must sleep an

- indefinitely lasting sleep, from which they will not wake up, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 51:39**)
- And I will make her princes and her wise ones, her governors and her deputy rulers and her mighty men **drunk**, and they must sleep an indefinitely lasting sleep, from which they will not wake up, is the utterance of the King, whose name is **Yehowah** of **armies**. (**Jeremiah 51:57**)
  - And you must **say**; **This** is how Babylon will sink down and never rise up because of the calamity that I **am** bringing in upon her, and they will certainly tire themselves out. Down to this point are the words of Jeremiah. (**Jeremiah 51:64**)
