

Jeremiah 25:3 From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon, the king of Judah, and down to this day, these twenty-three years the word of Yehowah has occurred to me, and I kept speaking to you people, rising up early and speaking, but you did not listen.

[15] - References:

- To whom the word of Yehowah occurred in the days of Josiah the son of Amon, the king of Judah, in the thirteenth year of his reigning. (Jeremiah 1:2)
- And Yehowah the God of their forefathers kept sending against them by means of his messengers, sending again and again, because he felt compassion for his people and for his dwelling. (2 Chronicles 36:15)
- O that my people were listening to me, O that Israel itself would walk in my very ways! (Psalms 81:13)
- And now for the reason that you kept doing all these works, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I kept speaking to you, getting up early and speaking, but you did not listen, and I kept calling you, but you did not answer. (Jeremiah 7:13)
- For I solemnly admonished your forefathers in the day of my bringing them up out of the land of Egypt and down to this day, rising up early and admonishing, saying; Obey my voice. (Jeremiah 11:7)
- This bad people who are refusing to obey my words, who are walking in the stubbornness of their heart and who keep walking after other gods in order to serve them and to bow down to them, will also become just like this belt that is fit for nothing. (Jeremiah 13:10)
- And you yourselves have acted worse in your doing than your fathers, and here you are walking each one after the stubbornness of his bad heart in not obeying me. (Jeremiah 16:12)
- And here there was a man of God that had come out of Judah by the word of Yehowah to Bethel, while Jeroboam was standing by the altar to make sacrificial smoke. (1 Kings 13:1)

- A man repeatedly reproveth but making his neck hard will suddenly be broken, and that without healing. (**Proverbs 29:1**)
- But they did not **listen** to me, and they did not incline their ear, but they **kept** hardening their neck. They acted worse than their forefathers! (**Jeremiah 7:26**)
- By listening to the **words** of my servants the prophets, whom I am sending to **you**, even **rising** up **early** and sending them, whom **you** have not listened to. (**Jeremiah 26:5**)
- And they **kept** turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a **rising** up **early** and teaching, but there were none of them listening to receive discipline. (**Jeremiah 32:33**)
- There **has** been a carrying out of the **words** of Jehonadab the **son** of Rechab, that he commanded his **sons**, to drink no wine, and they have drunk none **down** to this **day**, because they have obeyed the commandment of their forefather. And as for me, I have spoken to **you** men, **rising** up **early** and **speaking**, but **you** have not obeyed me. (**Jeremiah 35:14**)
- Take for yourself a roll of a book, and you must write in it all the **words** that I have spoken to you against Israel and against **Judah** and against all the nations, since the **day** that I spoke to you, since the **days** of **Josiah**, clear **down** to this **day**. (**Jeremiah 36:2**)
- My God will reject them, for they have not listened to him, and they will become fugitives among the nations. (**Hosea 9:17**)
