Jeremiah 25:31" A noise will certainly come clear to the farthest part¹ of the earth, for there is a controversy that Yehowah has with the nations. He must personally put himself in judgment with all flesh. As regards the wicked ones, he must give them to the sword, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- For Yehowah has a day of vengeance, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (Isaiah 34:8)
- Hear the word of Yehowah, O sons of Israel, for Yehowah has a legal case with the inhabitants of the land, for there is no truth nor loving-kindness nor knowledge of God in the land. (Hosea 4:1)
- And Yehowah has a legal case with Judah, even to hold an accounting against Jacob according to his ways, according to his dealings he will repay him. (Hosea 12:2)
- Hear, O you mountains, the legal case of Yehowah, also you durable objects, you foundations of the earth, for Yehowah has a legal case with his people, and it is with Israel that he will argue. (Micah 6:2)
- Therefore each one according to his ways is how I shall judge you, O house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. Turn back, yes, cause a turning back from all your transgressions, and let nothing prove to be for you people a stumbling block causing error. (Ezekiel 18:30)
- And I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples and put myself on judgment with you there face to face. (Ezekiel 20:35)
- As regards the wicked, they will be cut off from the very earth, and as for the treacherous, they will be torn away from it. (Proverbs 2:22)
- For as fire Yehowah himself will for a fact take up the controversy, yes, with his sword, against all flesh, and the slain of Yehowah will certainly become many. (Isaiah 66:16)

- By the sword they will die, all the sinners of my people, those who are saying; The calamity will not come near or reach as far as us. (Amos 9:10)
- I will also collect together all the nations and bring them down to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, and I will put myself on judgment with them there on account of my people and my inheritance Israel, whom they scattered among the nations, and they apportioned out my own land. (Joel 3:2)
- With the judicial sentence upon the wicked one you will certainly be filled, judicial sentence and justice will themselves take hold. (Job 36:17)
- At that time he will speak to them in his anger and in his hot displeasure he will disturb them. (Psalms 2:5)
- They will be delivered over to the power of the sword, they will become a mere portion for foxes. (Psalms 63:10)
- For it is the day belonging to Yehowah of armies. It is upon everyone self-exalted and lofty and upon everyone lifted up or low. (Isaiah 2:12)
- Attend to me in silence, you islands, and let national groups themselves regain power. Let them approach. At that time let them speak. Let us come up close together for the judgment itself. (Isaiah 41:1)
- There is where Edom, her kings and all her chieftains are, who, in their mightiness, were put with those slain by the sword, they themselves will lie down even with the uncircumcised ones and with those going down into the pit. (Ezekiel 32:29)
- Son of man, speak to the sons of your people, and you must say to them; As regards a land, in case I bring upon it a sword and the people of the land, one and all, actually take a man and set him as their watchman. (Ezekiel 33:2)
- And I will bring myself into judgment with him, with pestilence and with blood, and a flooding downpour and hailstones, fire and sulphur I shall rain down upon him and upon his bands and upon the many peoples that will be with him. (Ezekiel 38:22)
- And he will plant his palatial tents between the grand sea and the holy mountain of Decoration, and he will have to come all the

way to his end, and there will be no helper for him. (Daniel 11:45)
