- On this account gird on sackcloth, *you* people. Beat *your* breasts and howl, because the burning anger of Yehowah has not turned back from us. (**Jeremiah 4:8**)
- O daughter of my people, gird on sackcloth and **wallow** in the ashes. Make your mourning that for an only son, the wailing of bitterness, because suddenly the despoiler will come upon us. (**Jeremiah 6:26**)
- And as for *you* my sheep, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am judging between a sheep and a sheep, between the rams and the he-goats. (**Ezekiel 34:17**)
- Woe to you who are despoiling, without you yourself being despoiled, and to you who are dealing treacherously, without others having dealt treacherously with you! As soon as you **have** finished as a despoiler, you will be despoiled. As soon as you **have** done with dealing treacherously, they will deal treacherously with you. (**Isaiah 33:1**)
- Is this man Coniah a mere form despised, dashed to pieces, or a **vessel** in which there is no delight? Why is it that he himself and his offspring **must** be hurled down and thrown into the land that they **have** not known? (**Jeremiah 22:28**)
- A time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to wail and a time to skip **about**. (**Ecclesiastes 3:4**)
- Son of man, prophesy, and you **must** say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Howl, *you* people; Alas for the day! (**Ezekiel 30:2**)
- Howl, *you* inhabitants of Maktesh, for all the people who are tradesmen **have** been silenced, all those weighing **out** silver **have** been cut off. (**Zephaniah 1:11**)
