Jeremiah 25:9. Here I am sending and I will take all the families of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, even sending to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and I will bring them against this land and against its inhabitants and against all these nations round about, and I will devote them to destruction and make them an object of astonishment and something to whistle at and places devastated to time indefinite.

- Although he makes his voice gracious, do not believe in him, for there are seven detestable things in his heart. (Proverbs 26:25)
- And he has raised up a signal to a great nation far away, and he has whistled to it at the extremity of the earth, and, look! In haste it will swiftly come in. (Isaiah 5:26)
- For here I am calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly come and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all her walls round about and against all the cities of Judah. (Jeremiah 1:15)
- And now I myself have given all these lands into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and even the wild beasts of the field I have given him to serve him. (Jeremiah 27:6)
- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am sending and I will take Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and I will place his throne right above these stones that I have hidden, and he will certainly extend his state tent over them. (Jeremiah 43:10)
- Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar himself, the king of Babylon, made his military force perform a great service against Tyre. Every head was one made bald, and every shoulder was one rubbed bare. But as for wages, there proved to be none for him and his military force from Tyre for the service that he had performed against her. (Ezekiel 29:18)
- Yehowah will raise up against you a nation far away, from the end of the earth, just as an eagle pounces, a nation whose tongue you will not understand. (Deuteronomy 28:49)

- Here I am bringing in upon You men a nation from far away, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. It is an enduring nation. It is a nation of long ago, a nation whose language you do not know, and you cannot hear understandingly what they speak. (Jeremiah 5:15)
- And I will bring in the worst ones of the nations, and they will certainly take possession of their houses, and I will cause the pride of the strong ones to cease, and their sanctuaries must be profaned. (Ezekiel 7:24)
- Look! I am raising up against You, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah the God of the armies, a nation, and they must oppress You people from the entering in of Hamath down to the torrent valley of the Arabah. (Amos 6:14)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Here I am bringing against Tyre Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon from the north, a king of kings, with horses and war chariots and cavalrymen and a congregation, even a multitudinous people. (Ezekiel 26:7)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said;
 Here I am giving to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon the land
 of Egypt, and he must carry off its wealth and make a big spoil of
 it and do a great deal of plundering of it, and it must become
 wages for his military force. (Ezekiel 29:19)
- For here I am raising up the Chaldeans, the nation bitter and impetuous, which is going to the wide-open places of earth in order to take possession of residences not belonging to it. (Habakkuk 1:6)
- And I will make this city an object of astonishment and something to be whistled at. Every last one passing along by it will stare in astonishment and whistle over all its plagues. (Jeremiah 19:8)
- I will also cut Israel off from upon the surface of the ground that I have given to them, and the house that I have sanctified to my name I shall throw away from before me, and Israel will indeed become a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples. (1 Kings 9:7)

- In order to make their land an object of astonishment, for whistling at to time indefinite. Every last one passing along by it will stare in astonishment and shake his head. (Jeremiah 18:16)
- And you must become an object of astonishment, a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples to whom Yehowah will lead you away. (Deuteronomy 28:37)
- And I shall certainly stretch upon Jerusalem the measuring line applied to Samaria and also the leveling instrument applied to the house of Ahab, and I shall simply wipe Jerusalem clean just as one wipes the handleless bowl clean, wiping it clean and turning it upside down. (2 Kings 21:13)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (2 Chronicles 36:21)
- Howl, O gate! Cry out, O city! All of you must become disheartened, O Philistia! For out of the north a smoke is coming, and there is no one getting isolated from his ranks. (Isaiah 14:31)
- Raise a signal toward Zion. Make provision for shelter. Do not stand still. For there is a calamity that I am bringing in from the north, even a great crash. (Jeremiah 4:6)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Look! A people is coming from the land of the north, and there is a great nation that will be awakened from the remotest parts of the earth. (Jeremiah 6:22)
- At any moment that I may speak against a nation and against a kingdom to uproot it and to pull it down and to destroy it.

 (Jeremiah 18:7)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am making you a fright to yourself and to all your lovers, and they will certainly fall by the sword of their enemies while your eyes will be looking on, and all Judah I shall give into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he will actually take them into exile in Babylon and strike them down with the sword. (Jeremiah 20:4)
- And I will pursue after them with the sword, with the famine and with the pestilence, and I will give them for a quaking to all the kingdoms of the earth, for a curse and for an object of astonishment and for a whistling at and for a reproach among all

the nations to which I shall certainly disperse them. (Jeremiah 29:18)

- Take for yourself a roll of a book, and you must write in it all the words that I have spoken to you against Israel and against Judah and against all the nations, since the day that I spoke to you, since the days of Josiah, clear down to this day. (Jeremiah 36:2)
- Let not the swift one try to flee, and let not the mighty man try to escape. Up north by the bank of the river Euphrates they have stumbled and fallen. (Jeremiah 46:6)
- As for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah, for I am with you. For I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have dispersed you, but with you I shall make no extermination. Yet I shall have to chastise you to the proper degree, and I shall absolutely not leave you unpunished. (Jeremiah 46:28)
- Because of the indignation of Yehowah she will not be inhabited, and she must become a desolate waste in her entirety. As for anyone passing along by Babylon, he will stare in astonishment and whistle on account of all her plagues. (Jeremiah 50:13)
- Here I am against you, O ruinous mountain, is the utterance of Yehowah, you ruiner of the whole earth, and I will stretch out my hand against you and roll you away from the crags and make you a burnt-out mountain. (Jeremiah 51:25)
- And these the king of Babylon proceeded to strike down and to put them to death in Riblah in the land of Hamath. Thus Judah went into exile from off its soil. (Jeremiah 52:27)
- At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept wagging their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the city of which they used to say, It is the perfection of prettiness, an exultation for all the earth? (Lamentations 2:15)
- And the inhabited cities themselves will be devastated, and the land itself will become a mere desolate waste, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 12:20)
- Or were it a sword that I should bring upon that land, and should I actually say; Let a sword itself pass through the land, and

- should I actually cut off from it earthling man and domestic animal. (Ezekiel 14:17)
- And they must bring up against you a congregation and pelt you with stones and slaughter you with their swords. (Ezekiel 16:40)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; There will be the bringing up of a congregation against them and a making of them a frightful object and something to plunder. (Ezekiel 23:46)
- Therefore, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah! This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys and to the devastated places that were laid desolate and to the abandoned cities that have come to be for plunder and for ridicule to the remaining ones of the nations that are round about. (Ezekiel 36:4)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I myself have raised my hand in an oath that the nations that you have round about, they themselves will bear their own humiliation. (Ezekiel 36:7)
- And the desolated land itself will be cultivated, whereas it had become a desolate waste before the eyes of every passerby. (Ezekiel 36:34)
- And because of the greatness that He gave him, all peoples, national groups and languages proved to be quaking and showing fear before him. Whom he happened to want to, he was killing, and whom he happened to want to, he was striking, and whom he happened to want to, he was exalting, and whom he happened to want to, he was humiliating. (Daniel 5:19)
- In that day one will raise up concerning you people a proverbial saying and will certainly lament a lamentation, even a lamentation. One will have to say; We have positively been despoiled! The very portion of my people he alters. How he removes it from me! To the unfaithful one he apportions out our own fields. (Micah 2:4)
- One that does a scattering has come up before your face. Let there be a safeguarding of the fortified place. Watch the way. Strengthen the hips. Reinforce power very much. (Nahum 2:1)

- In its entirety it comes for mere violence. The assembling of their faces is as the east wind, and it gathers up captives just like the sand. (Habakkuk 1:9)
- As for the one in which the black horses are, they are going forth to the land of the north, and as for the white ones, they must go forth to behind the sea, and as for the speckled ones, they must go forth to the land of the south. (Zechariah 6:6)
