Jeremiah 26:18" Micah<sup>1</sup> of Moresheth<sup>2</sup> himself happened to be prophesying in the days of Hezekiah<sup>3</sup> the king of Judah and went on to say to all the people of Judah; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Zion herself will be plowed up as a mere field, and Jerusalem herself will become mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the House will be for high places of a forest.

- The word of Yehowah that occurred to Micah of Moresheth, in the days of Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah, kings of Judah, that he visioned concerning Samaria and Jerusalem. (Micah 1:1)
- Therefore you will give parting gifts to Moresheth-gath. The houses of Achzib were as something deceitful to the kings of Israel. (Micah 1:14)
- Hezekiah himself became king at the age of twenty-five years, and for twenty-nine years he reigned in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Abijah the daughter of Zechariah. (2 Chronicles 29:1)
- O God, the nations have come into your inheritance, they have defiled your holy temple, they have laid Jerusalem in a heap of ruins. (Psalms 79:1)

- And he proceeded to burn the house of Yehowah and the house of the king and all the houses of Jerusalem, and every great house he burned with fire. (Jeremiah 52:13)
- On account of Zion's mountain that is desolated, foxes themselves have walked on it. (Lamentations 5:18)
- And I will lay desolate her vine and her fig tree, of which she has said; They are a gift to me, which my passionate lovers have given to me, and I will set them as a forest, and the wild beast of the field will certainly devour them. (Hosea 2:12)
- Is it the time for You yourselves to dwell in YOUR paneled houses, while this house is waste? (Haggai 1:4)
